
















The elections are over with -HALLELULIA!




A Word from the Heart

Knowing how to pray and what to pray for is a concern of God's children. We buy books and read the stories of praying Christians. We search for a pattern, one that will give us the correct words to say or perhaps a formula of some sort that will unlock the power of heaven on our behalf. Another issue is making sure our hearts are right with our Lord. This is needed. However, unless you are in a deplorable spiritual condition one ought to be able to enter a time of prayer with confidence. Our Lord intercedes for us and knows our hearts condition and burdens.

A careful reading of the New Testament teaches us about the many issues on the hearts of the Apostles; about matters such as health, open doors for the gospel, supply of finances, love among the Christians, harmony in the local fellowship and the inner strength all believers need in daily living. In Philippians 1:9-1 1 Paul prays for the Christians inner strength and spiritual insight. It is for an awareness of their hope and present life in the Lord. Similar prayers are found in Ephesians 1:16-21 and Colossians 1:9-14. Paul's desire is for them to increase in love one for another. They had shown their love for Paul by sending gifts to him on numerous occasions. He did not want them to stop at that point; he wanted their love one for another to abound and to find other people to love. We want and increase in wealth, success, and recognition, but how often do we ask God to increase our love for each? Our culture is constantly setting and evaluating its goals, let's re-evaluate this one as well.



The love the apostle desires is not a mere sentimentality, not a just and stirring of the human emotions brought on by tragic circumstances that people suffer. Paul's desire is to have the believer's love regulated by a deeper knowledge of spiritual needs. This of course includes prayer for our spiritual needs and understanding of the Word and our practice of His Word. The world around has said that love is blind. It is a way of saying people are often too sympathetic or emotional in choosing

where or how to use their gifts or resources. True Christian love is alert looking for opportunities to serve the Lord. The typical evangelical is one of the most critical individuals around. We have so distorted the idea of discernment that we feel we have insight into everybody's motives and business. By discernment Paul is speaking of sensitiveness to proper values. Is it possible to waste our love on the wrong cause?

The knowledge we need is so that we can evaluate correctly. We won't let our children make some decisions until there is evidence that they have developed discernment. We need to group up so that we can approve the things that are excellent. We can spend time and energy on things that are of no real worth. We need to be alert to the counterfeit. What is disturbing is a belief that if I am right' about a version of the Bible, a method of service, a style of worship, or an interpretation of a verse of scripture. That gives me a right to suspend love and demand that others meet my standards before I will go out of my way to love them. Don't ask others to measure up, but spend time thinking about growing in love and serving.

Thousands of Bibles Will Show Up in Public Schools Soon and It's Perfectly Legal



Since the 1962 landmark Supreme Court decision to remove prayer from public schools, Christians have fought to regain ground lost to political correctness.

More than 50 years after the ban on government endorsed prayer in school, one ministry is hoping to revisit the discus-

sion by bringing the Bible back to school yards across America.

More than 300,000 students will let their light shine on their local campus through an initiative call "Bring Your Bible to School Day", backed by Focus on the Family. The one day event is completely student directed, meaning Christian youth groups lead the activities.

Focus on the Family says the purpose is to empower students to express their faith in a respectful way that shows the love of Christ.

In this season where religious freedom is a hotly debated topic, parents and participating students are encouraged to know their legal rights. Though there may be some negative reaction to witnessing on school grounds, they say bringing your Bible to school is a way of celebrating faith and religious freedom at the same time.

Students who voluntarily join this movement are encouraged to be a "voice of hope" while also respecting authority.

Focus on the Family points to your biblical leaders such as Daniel, Esther and Timothy who changed their culture by "taking a courageous stand for their belief in God."

Crosses, Symbol of Christ's Victory Over Evil, in Christian Towns Liberated from ISIS

After years of suffering under the Islamic State terrorist group, Christians triumphantly returned the Cross, the symbol of Christ's victory over evil, to villages in Iraq's Nineveh Plain.

As Iraqi and Kurdish security forces continue to clear formerly held ISIS territory, Christian leaders are slowly trickling back to their homelands - including Father Thabet, who brought a cross, the size of a man, covered with flowers, with him when he returned to his home village of Karamles.

Upon arriving home, he discovered his church had been heavily damaged by ISIS, and its cross thrown to the ground. Undeterred, the priest climbed Barbara Hill, next to his village, and planted the cross firmly in the ground overlooking his hometown.

"I am so happy I can do this. I'm smiling from cheek to cheek and I weep tears of joy at the same time. This is the trip I have been praying for, for two years now," he said, according to World Watch Monitor.

how the three gift presenters arrived—there was fire truck on the side of the picture.





AMY GRANT RESPONDS AFTER LIFEWAY REFUSES TO SELL CHRISTMAS ALBUM BECAUSE IT'S 'NOT CHRISTIAN ENOUGH'



Amy Grant has responded to LifeWay Christian Resources' decision not to sell her new Christmas album this year because it's not "Christian enough," but encouraged her followers to continue discussing what it truly means to be a follower of Christ.

"We respectfully accept Lifeway's decision that my new Christmas album didn't meet their criteria. Let's all move on from that decision without arguing about it. But let's not stop asking the questions about what it means to live in faith and reflect love to the world around us," said Grant, in a Wednesday post on her official Facebook account.

"Asking questions opens all of us up to the possibility of being willing to consider how we might live differently," the Nashville-based singer continued. "We are all loved by God...all of us...How we communicate that experience is unique to each of us...Unity is not about everybody being the same...it's about all of us coming together...with our differences."

"Tennessee Christmas" was released Oct. 21 and its 13 tracks are a mix of Christmas hymns, Christmas mainstays and original songs. According to The Tennesseean, LifeWay, the publishing arm of the Southern Baptist Convention, announced earlier this week its retail stores are not carrying the album, "Tennessee Christmas", but would not comment on the reasons for the decision.

Each stalk of wheat has an even number of grains.


Every bunch of bananas has on its lowest row an even number of bananas, and each row decreases by one, so that one row has an even number and the next row an odd number.

Columbine Mother Shares How Christian Faith, Daughter's Example Allowed Her to Forgive: Exclusive Interview



Beth Nimmo, the mother of Rachel Joy Scott, the first student killed in the Columbine High School massacre in 1999, has shared how her Christian faith allowed her to forgive her daughter's murderers and use her story to inspire others.

Rachel, a 17-year-old student known for her Christian faith throughout the Colorado school, was sitting on a patch of grass eating lunch with her friend when

18-year-old Eric Harris and 17-year-old Dylan Klebold approached her, shooting her three times. After realizing Rachel was still alive, the killers returned and asked her, "Do you still believe in God?" She answered, "You know I do", whereupon he replied "Then go be with Him" and shot her in the head.

"The Lord commands us to forgive, and I know Rachel would have forgiven her killers," Nimmo said. "She was on their target list and she had tried to reach out to them - she'd already put herself out there where her shooters were concerned... I forgive, because for Rachel, that day was a life sentence. But, for it to not be my life sentence, I have to turn it over to the Lord and say, 'It wasn't right, but I want you to free me in my heart and mind from living in the pain of that moment."



Nimmo has authored several books about Rachel's life - "Rachel's Tears" and "The Journals of Rachel Scott" - and shares her daughter's story with students around the world to relay the importance of inclusion, compassion, and forgiveness.

"I share the point that if I had to face those two shooters that day and I said, 'I forgive you,' they would have laughed and mocked me to my face," she explained.

"But, forgiveness is about you, not them, it's giving you the key to unlock the emotional and physical prison that the violator put you in."

Nimmo emphasized that it's crucial to understand that forgiveness doesn't mean saying everything is okay: "A lot of people are afraid to forgive, because they think it means what happened to them, the violation, whether it was emotional, physical, financial thing, that forgiveness means what happened to them is okay," she said, "But forgiveness doesn't mean that violation is okay, and I share that all the time with kids, because forgiveness isn't for the violator, it's for the person."

Nearly 17 years after her death, Rachel's story will be told in an upcoming film, I'm Not Ashamed, which examines the young woman's courage, deep faith, and love for others. The film, which hits theaters Oct. 21, is based on journals and pictures Rachel left behind, in which she wrote about her faith and expressed a prophetic belief that her life would be cut short.

Nimmo hopes the film, which stars Sadie Robertson and Ben Davies, will inspire viewers of all ages and encourage students to stand firm in their faith and understand that they're not alone - regardless of what society tells them.

"By sharing Rachel's story, we're talking about a young girl who faced peer pressures and how she fought to be authentic, and we show her struggles," Nimmo said. "It wasn't easy; she struggled at times, but she's honest and she poured her heart out to the Lord and is constantly asking to be used by Him. He honored that request and He helped her stay true to what she wanted to do."

She added, "Kids today are constantly faced with double standards and mixed signals - culture is cultivating their values and what's important. The church needs to counteract those influences; it's difficult for kids today - they don't know what truth looks like and they're searching everywhere. Kids that love the Lord feel isolated, that they're the only ones. Rachel talks about it. This brings it all out - the movie is honest. We've tried to be true to her writing, and it's just as relevant for kids today as it was 17 years ago."

Over 19K Sign Petition Condemning Georgia for Demanding That a Pastor Turn Over His Sermons, Bible

An online petition started by the Family Research Council condemns Georgia officials for demanding that a Seventh-day Adventist lay minister hand over his sermons to the state government, calling it an attempt to silence people of faith.

"I stand with Dr. Eric Walsh's freedom to believe and live according to his deeply-held beliefs. The demand that he hand over his sermons, sermon notes, and all pastoral documents including his Bible represents a government intrusion into the sanctity of the church, pastor's study, and pulpit," reads the petition to Georgia Governor Nathan Deal.

"Heavy-handed tactics like this have the effect of intimidating and silencing people of faith everywhere. Such targeting of the pulpit by the government is unconscionable, and I urge you to use all means of your authority to correct this egregious overreach of the state into church affairs."

In Memorium: Jack Chick

"Brother Jack Chick passed away Sunday evening, October 23, peacefully in his sleep. He was 92," Chick Publications' Facebook page announced.

He had been suffering from poor health weeks before he died, according to his long-time secretary Karen Rockney, The Guardian reported.

Chick was best known for creating small cartoon pamphlets, also known as Chick tracts or "chicklets," which tackled different topics like false religions, Halloween, homosexuality, witchcraft and the occult and abortion. He also focused on contemporary issues in his comics. His works all had one thing in common: they pointed the reader to Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior.

For example, one of his works, entitled "Dark Dungeons," discussed the real and imminent harm of participating in the fantasy

Chick embraced the Christian faith by listening to Charles E. Fuller's radio program "Old Fashioned Revival Hour," which he and his wife listened to regularly by the insistence of his in-laws.

He was reportedly struck when Fuller quoted the Bible: "Though your sins be as scarlet, they shall be as white as snow." God touched his heart and he surrendered his life to Christ, according to Christian Comics International.

Chicago Cubs' Ben Zobrist 'Heart' of Club But His Soul Belongs to God as Avowed Christian



Ben Zobrist, Chicago Cubs' second basemen and left fielder, is the son of a pastor and an avowed Christian. He also is someone who just tied an obscure record with Babe Ruth by becoming the second player to have three hits in Game 1 of consecutive World Series baseball appearances. Additionally, he was named 2016 World Series MVP after hitting a go-ahead RBI double in the 10th inning of Wednesday night's Game 7 win over the Cleveland Indians.

"I feel pretty good," Zobrist told the Sporting News. "Obviously when you hit a few balls your confidence goes up and hopefully you

can square a few more up. Hopefully that continues."

"Ben Zobrist is becoming my favorite baseball player," Cubs' catcher David Ross said. "Ben is just humble and asked to do so many things through the season. He played second base through most of the year and hasn't spent a day at second in the postseason."

Last year, Zobrist played for the Kansas City Royals, the winner of the 2015 World Series. He had six hits, including four doubles, and three walks in 26 visits to the plate. He scored five runs in five games and helped the Royals win the World Series.

Zobrist grew up in central Illinois where he was a star high school athlete. His father, Tom, was pastor of Liberty Bible Church in Eureka, reports Christian Index.

The Chicago Tribune reported, "Zobrist had planned to follow his dad, Tom, the pastor of Liberty Bible Church, into the ministry after graduating near the top of his class when he spent \$50 of his birthday money to attend a tryout in nearby Peoria."

An Olivet Nazarene University coach then offered Zobrist a baseball scholarship, whereat he played baseball for three years and then transferred to Dallas Baptist University. The four-sport high school athlete developed enough all-around skills to be drafted out of Dallas Baptist University by the Houston Astros.

The Tribune reported: "There was the night Ben was drafted in 2004 and pledged to his clergyman father to 'represent God and be a missionary in baseball."

Zobrist's wife, Julianna, is a popular Christian singer with a successful career of her own. They bonded over their dedication to their faith and their hopes of raising a Christian family together.

Ross said Zobrist was the club's leader in this World Series. "He's a guy who you lean on who has been in this moment."




