

*Us*, a magazine for ministry wives and women in church leadership.




#### **PASTORS / CHURCHES - YOU NEED ADF**

Psalm 100 is a psalm of thanksgiving and praise. We are often thankful we are not like others who are hungry, living in political oppression or fighting a debilitating disease. But true thanksgiving begins with God not with human comparisons. The psalmist tells WHY we can be thankful and WAYS to thank him.


The Lord is God. Our worship must be intelligent. We ought to know whom we worship and why. Our God is a covenant keeping God. Abraham didn't know the land of destination but knew the Lord as God (Gen. 14:22) Moses had no idea how to feed millions but he too knew the Lord as God. (Ex. 16: 12)

God created us. (vs.3) Some call themselves self-made men but we acknowledge that we are fearfully and wonderfully made. He made all things for himself and upholds all things.

He has redeemed us. (vs.3) We are his people by creation and by redemption. We are saved by the precious blood of Christ and belong to him for all eternity.

He cares for us. (vs. 3) He bears responsibility for his sheep. We are provided for by his loving care and we are under his holy and wise rule.

God is good. (vs.5) His grace gives us what we don't deserve. If he has given us his greatest gift, we can certainly as for lesser ones.



His mercy is everlasting. We are weak and as we look at our own lives we see how merciful he has been.

His truth endures to all generations. He does not promise and then revoke. He has entered into a covenant with his people.

The psalmist also gives us WAYS to thank God.

Make a joyful noise. God should be worshipped by a happy people. When the kind appears his loyal subjects give a glad shout. We ought to cultivate this in our lives. We must be not envious or look at the dark side of our experience. We too often regard our ordinary mercies as mere matters of course.

Serve the Lord with gladness. When we do service to God it is not bondage but rather a joyous experience.

Sing to God. We should not always be sighing. "He has put a new song in my mouth" Psalm 40: 1-3.

Be thankful to God. (vs.4) We must give thanks for who he is and what he does. We are to pray with thanksgiving so as not to forget what we have. (Phil. 4:6)

Praise God for who he is. Think of his attributes and bless his name. The last verse in the book of Psalms says "let everything that has breath praise the Lord. Hallelujah."

# HAPPY BIRTHDAY BILLY! Billy Graham Reveals 'One Thing' He Would Change About 'Evil, Chaotic' World

Famed evangelist Billy Graham has said that if he could change one thing about the world, it would be the hearts and minds of mankind, as evil and chaos won't end until all of humanity surrenders to Jesus.


The 98-year-old evangelist shared his thoughts in a recent "My Answer" column in response to a question posed by a reader: "If you could change just one thing about the world, what would it

be?" the reader asked. "I suppose in some ways the world is a better place than it was a few centuries ago, but when I look at today's headlines it doesn't seem like we've made any progress, does it?"

"America's Pastor," who turned 99 on November 7, first acknowledges that the reader is right, as the human race has faced the same problems throughout history -- wars, famines, conflicts, immorality, loneliness, irrational evil -- despite advances in science and technology.

"The Bible's diagnosis is still true: 'Yet man is born to trouble as surely as sparks fly upward' (Job 5:7)," he says.

What is our basic problem? The founder of the Billy Graham Evangelistic Association



contends that the basic problem is within our own hearts and minds.

"Even if we invent things that will bring great benefit to the human race, evil minds will use them to bring great destruction," he explains. "How else can you explain (for example) those who hack our computers or distribute dangerous drugs that can kill thousands? The prophet Jeremiah was right: "The heart is deceitful above

all things and beyond cure. Who can understand it?' (Jeremiah 17:9)."

Answering the readers' original question, Graham said if he could change "one thing" about the world, " it would be our hearts and minds."

"But I can't do that, and neither can anyone else-except God," he admits. "This is why we need Christ, for only He can change us from within by His Holy Spirit. And this can happen, as we turn to Him and invite Him to come into our lives as our Savior and Lord."

While we live in a world that's often "chaotic and evil," those who turn to Christ for forgiveness and new life can have peace, Graham said.

Billy Graham's son, Franklin, warned that the string of natural disasters unfolding around the world -- including the wildfires on the West Coast, violent hurricanes, and Mexico's magnitude 8.1 earthquake -- could be "Biblical signs before Christ's return."

He noted, Luke 21:25 reads, "There will be signs in sun and moon and stars, and on the earth distress of nations in perplexity because of the roaring of the sea and the waves."

Matthew 24:7 says, "For nation will rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom, and there will be famines and earthquakes in various places."

The younger Graham said, "These are some of the Biblical signs before Christ's return. Nobody knows the day or hour, not even the Son of God, but it is a reminder to all of us to be ready to repent and confess our sins, and ask for God's forgiveness. In the meantime, we can find comfort, peace, and hope in Him."

The evangelist added, "As we pray for all those affected by the current disasters, we should also remember God's promise to us in John 16:33, 'I have said these things to you, that in me you may have peace. In the world you will have tribulation. But take heart; I have overcome the world'."

#### **New Poll Shows Vast Majority of Pastors Want Freedom to Speak**

Alliance Defending Freedom (ADF) this week announced the results of a research poll showing 91 percent of Protestant pastors wanting the ability to speak freely from the pulpit without a chill from government. Moreover, more than 7 in 10 of the pastors wanted Congress to ensure the IRS is not empowered to punish churches based on the content of sermons.

This research buttresses efforts to lift the free speech burden of the infamous "Johnson Amendment," named for then-Senate Democratic Lead-

er (later to become President) Lyndon B. Johnson (D-Texas) who authored the 1954 provision to stop Section 501(c)(3) organizations from "intervening" in political campaigns. That language has since been interpreted to bar ministers and nonprofit leaders from making political statements at their organizations' functions or in their publications. In addition to being constitutionally suspect, this rule has



been vaguely and inconsistently applied by the IRS, resulting in a chilling effect.

The study also calls into question the extent of support for a push by some religious leaders who have told Congress that maintaining the power of the IRS to referee their speech is critical to "protecting the independence and integrity" of their ministries. That effort was spearheaded by Americans United for Separation of Church and State and the Baptist Joint Committee for Religious Liberty.

Regarding the survey, ADF Legal Counsel Christiana Holcomb said, "Churches and their pastors have a constitutionally protected freedom to decide for themselves what they want to say or not say. This poll demonstrates that religious leaders don't want to be burdened by the continual threat of an IRS investigation and potential penalties based simply on what they say from the pulpit."

#### African-American Leaders Defend Colorado Baker Amid Supreme Court Gay Wedding Cake Battle

A group of African-American rights activists have spoken out in defense of Colorado Christian baker Jack Phillips of Masterpiece Cakeshop as his religious freedom case will be argued before the United States Supreme Court in December.



Three conservative African-American public policy groups — the Frederick Douglass Foundation, Star Parker's Center of Urban Renewal and Education (CURE) and pro-life activist Ryan Bomberger's Radiance Foundation — launched a new website titled WeGotYour-BackJack.com in support of Phillip's First Amendment right.

The website was announced at a press conference outside the U.S. Supreme Court building in Washington, D.C. in which a handful of African-American activists and leaders spoke in defense of Phillips.

Among those who spoke at the press conference were Dean Nelson, the chairman and co-founder of the Frederick Douglass Foundation, and Rev. William Avon Keen, the president of the Southern Christian Leadership Conference of Virginia, which was founded by Dr. Martin Luther King Jr.

Bieber took the stage at the Hand in Hand: A Benefit For Hurricane Harvey and Irma Relief telethon to introduce a prayer.

Flanked by Pastor John Gray, Rabbi Ari Lukas, and Jihad Turk, Bieber

encouraged viewers to give to the cause before praying. "



According to reports, the event, attended by a slew of celebrities including Oprah Winfrey, George Clooney and Julia Roberts, has raised more than \$44 million for the victims of Hurricanes Harvey and Irma.

After cancelling the remainder of his "Purpose" tour, Bieber, who rededicated his life to Christ and regularly spends time with pastors Carl Lentz, Chad Veach, and Judah Smith, last month penned a letter revealing he's focused on working on his "mind, heart, and soul" to be "sustainable" so he could become a better man.



On the Life Without Limbs website, Nick Vujicic said he started his ministry to encourage others who, like him, have faced "countless challenges and obstacles," to remember that with God, anything is possible.

Limbless evangelist Nick Vujicic has thanked God after his team witnessed 400,000 people repent of their sins and begin their spiritual journey with Jesus Christ at a recent event in Ukraine.

"The biggest event that our team at Life Without Limbs has seen and maybe the largest event ever in Europe - 800,000 people in the streets of Kyiv Ukraine! Thank you God," Vujicic wrote on Facebook.

"400,000 repented of their sins and began their spiritual journey with Jesus - Now LWL celebrates the witness of 1 million decisions to walk with and trust God in everything face to face," he added.

Vujicic, 33, also said he recently stopped in Russia on his evangelism tour, where he stayed for 40 hours.

"Unfortunately I wasn't able to meet the President this trip but we continue to plant seeds of love and hope across this country until some unique doors open to share - thank you for your support," he wrote in an update.



Vujicic was born without arms or legs, and was given no medical reason for this condition. Despite the challenges he's faced, he is today a world-renowned inspirational speaker and author.

#### NORTH KOREAN PASTOR TORTURED FOR CHRISTIAN FAITH SAYS LIFE IN U.S. IS 'HEAVEN' AFTER LIVING IN 'HELL'

Choi Kwanghyuk, a pastor, was able to flee his native North Korea. Today, he lives in California, which he says is "heaven" compared to the horrors he once experienced.

Choi Kwanghyuk, 55, fled North Korea several years ago and now lives in Los Angeles, CA: "There is an enormous difference between my life in North Korea and my life in the U.S," he told Fox News. "The life in North Korea is hell ... life in America is heaven."

Being a Christian in the officially atheist state where public worship is forbidden was incredibly dangerous, yet he felt compelled to share the gospel with others.

While living in North Hamgyong province, Choi started an underground church, where congregants worshipped with only one Bible.

## GREG LAURIE: NO CHRISTIAN IS 'OFF THE HOOK,' ALL ARE CALLED TO EVANGELIZE, MAKE DISCIPLES

Every Christian has a responsibility to evangelize and try to bring people to Jesus Christ, says megachurch Pastor Greg Laurie, describing discipleship as not unlike a plane's safety instructions.

Laurie, who leads Harvest Christian Fellowship in Riverside, California, reflected on Jesus' Words in Matthew 28.

In Matthew 28, Jesus Christ said: "Go into all the world and make disciples of all nations, teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you, and lo I am with you even to the end of the age."

Laurie explained what the passage means, saying: "It means go out, [and] to the best of your ability, lead people to Christ, get them on their feet spiritually, and go and repeat the process again, and again, and again."

He added: "It's sort of like, wash, rinse, repeat — evangelize, discipleship, do it again. We're all called to do this, no one gets off the hook."

Laurie said that in order for people to make disciples, they must first be disciples themselves.

"You know when you're on the planes and they're telling you what to do in case you lose oxygen, and the masks come down? They say first put it on yourself, then on your child. Why? Because you can't help your kid if you're not getting oxygen," he said.

"You can't help others if you don't know God as you ought to."

#### NFL QB Carson Wentz Explains the 'Lie' Satan Wants Christians to Believe

Philadelphia Eagles quarterback Carson Wentz explained one "lie" about the Christian faith that Satan wants people to believe while sharing his faith at a live event held at Eastern University in Pennsylvania.

The 24-year-old Wentz, who is in his second season with the Eagles after a successful collegiate career at North Dakota State University, appeared at a special live event hosted by "Faith on The Field" radio show.

Considering that Wentz grew up as a Lutheran but is now a non-denominational Christian, he was asked during the show, which will air on the radio Monday, to explain where he currently is in his faith.

Wentz went on to talk about the lie that a lot of Christians believe and one that he admitted falling into the trap of while growing up. "I think talking specifically about that and being saved by works is obviously a lie, but it's a lie that a lot of people believe. It's a lie just in our culture. I know for me as a man, even when I was a kid, with

sports and anything I did, I was going to work my tail off to earn what I got. That's how I was wired, that's how the world kind of instills this value, so to speak, is work, work, work, and earn it," he said.

"And that's kind of what I thought. I'd pray, I'd go to church, I'd do this and that, and I'm like that's great, I'm a good person, I did the right and so I'm going to be saved naturally. That's what I thought," he added. "That's the lie that the devil wants you to believe."

Wentz also shared the Bible verse that really changed his perspective of salvation.

"Ephesians 2:8-10 — 'For it is by Grace that you have been saved through faith —

and this is not of yourselves, it is the gift of God — not by works, so that no one can boast. For we are God's handiwork, created in Christ Jesus to do go works which God prepared in advance for us to do."

According to Wentz, the notion that people are saved through works and not a relationship with Christ is a "misconception that a lot of people have."


