A Word From the Heart


Remember God's Word. The Christian Church at the beginning of the 21st century does not seem to believe in an immutable God, believing today that His character is not eternally the same. His teachings. are no more than putty, easily shaped into the morals of any time and place.

We do not think in terms of God's truth, verses a hostile world. We feel our failure is a result of not using enough of the world's methods, or supporting and joining the world's causes. It is easy for believers in Christ, to believe in a weak God motif by seeking change through politics.

The Apostle Peter was writing to a generation of believers who could be easily led from the truth by cleverly devised arguments. They would have to

be alert to teachings that ultimately lead to "denying the Lord who bought them" (2 Peter 2:1-3). Peter's approach to this seems almost embarrassingly out of step with many of today's ideas. Peter feels an urgency to remind believers of the present truth in which they are established. Notice the words: 'I will not be negligent to remind you": "Yes, I think it is right, as long as I am in this tent, to stir you up by reminding you" and "I will be careful to ensure that you always have a reminder of these things." (2 Peter 1:12,13,15)

There are three key thoughts in these verses. The first, of course, are the words "to remind", "by reminding", and "a reminder" of these things. Is our problem really a lack of not mastering the latest meth-



ods of change? We seek change and re-invention and too much accommodation to the latest fads and pressures of the ever changing morals of our time. The past as well as "old Truth" is frowned on as the cause of our present problems. A "reminding" ministry is essential to our survival. If we do not stand on the slid foundation of revealed truth, we will be like the Roman Colosseum that is nothing more than a tourist attraction of a long ago dead society. Peter would not be derelict to remind them. His one goal is clearly set forth. He will give diligence to make sure they know what is right. That almost seems a waste of time to us. He felt the real impact of the Church was not snuggling up to the world, but clearly confronting it with eternal truth

The final point of Peter's desire is to "stir you up." The idea is not a gentle stir of a wee cup of tea, but the violent blowing of a storm upon the sea. (John 6:18) Very few will sleep through a storm. It will awaken us to dangers. He knew that our minds have a tendency to get accustomed to truth and take it for granted. Knowing the truth is no guarantee we will always remember it and apply it. Instead of running with arms wide open to the pagan god of expediency and buying their cure all elixir, Peter suggest a good stir up of our spiritual life. If not we will continue to mix with the world view and look more and more like the world we profess to reject.

James MacDonald: 7 Reasons Why Christian Leaders Fall

Within weeks, one of my heroes has fallen, and some of my friends in pastoral ministry have taken detours in their destiny as well. Failings among leaders are becoming an epidemic. No one is beyond the reach of Satan's grasp.

Since January, our new radio program has been trying to contact Walk in the Word to air pastor James MacDonald's messages; that's when everything started to unfold. Although I'm disappointed, my faith is not shaken because only Christ should be placed on a pedestal. I'm convinced that Pastor James

will do what is right and be an example for all of us. He has been a great help to me and many others over the years. Pastor James, if you're reading this, use this opportunity as a stepping stone, not a stumbling block, and come back stronger than before. We love you and want to encourage you.

Why do leaders fall? They fall for the same reason that all Christians fall. Each of us are drawn away by our own evil desires and enticed. Most bold pastors are susceptible to pride and being too harsh. It's hard to tame a Type A personality. We need to be vigilant and abort sin when it's conceived (cf. James 1:14-15). Sin has a life cycle—it either grows or withers depending on whether we feed or starve it. John Owen, the prolific Puritan author wrote, "Be killing sin, or sin will be killing you."

Consider the following ways that sin gains entrance. I shared these in a past blog but they are worth repeating. The old devil has no new tricks:



1. "IT WILL NEVER HAPPEN TO ME."

1 Corinthians 10:12 reminds us that if we think that we are standing firm, we should be careful that we don't fall. "Pride goes before destruction, a haughty spirit before a fall" (Proverbs 16:18). Pride says, "Tve never committed adultery. It will never happen to me." Humility says, "By the grace of God, I haven't, but I can." Strength is found in admitting our weaknesses: "For when I am weak I am strong" (2 Corinthians 12:10). Pride opens the door to compromise and unwise decisions;

it ignores conviction. Conviction is not always a hammer to the head, it's a still small voice to the heart. Sadly, many confuse God's patience with His approval. C.H. Spurgeon rightly noted, "We are never, never so much in danger of being proud as when we think we are humble."

2. I'M "TOO BUSY."

We are all susceptible to putting God second and ministry first. If we're too busy to cultivate a prayer life that places God first—we're too busy. Men would live better if they prayed better. We're often too busy because we're doing too much. "When faith ceases to pray, it ceases to live" (E.M. Bounds). It's hard to fall when you're always on your knees. Moral failing and spiritual abuse cannot gain a stronghold in a broken, praying heart that spends time in the Word and obedience to it (cf. James 1:22). Nine times out of ten, when a leader falls, he or she has no meaningful prayer or devotional life.

3. HOLINESS IS COMPROMISED.

The enemy attempts to draw us away from God's holy standard. I vividly remember a story of a young boy who kept falling out of his bed. He finally asked his mother why he kept falling. She wisely answered, "It's because you don't stay far enough in." In the same way, many of us fall back into sin because we don't get far enough into God's framework of safety and protection via holiness. In the words of Isaac Watts, "True Christianity, where it reigns in the heart, will make itself appear in the purity of life."

Of all the attributes of God described in the Bible, holiness is seen most often. Holiness is a vital weapon of defense against the enemies attack (cf. Ephesians 6:14). But holiness must come from brokenness and humility not legalism. A low view of holiness always damages morality...we rationalize instead of repent. I'm convinced that today's media plays a significant role in the decline of holiness. Sadly, Hollywood, not the Holy Spirit, influences many. We cannot fill our mind with darkness all week and expect the light of Christ to shine in our lives.

4. MANY BUILD UNHEALTHY RELATIONSHIPS WITH THE OP-POSITE SEX.

We must be on high alert in this area and have tremendous steps of accountability in place. The devil doesn't show those involved in counseling appointments, inner office meetings, and private "fellowship" the pain and anguish and the years of regret that moral failure brings; he deceives them with a false sense of freedom in ministry... that we are simply "helping" the other person. If you are married and attracted to another person, or if the potential is there, take steps now and remove yourself from the environment. Adultery begins with small compromises. We're often too smart to take deliberate plunges, but we're easily enticed to take one step at a time, one compromise at a time, one bad choice at a time until we're at the bottom. Don't fight sexual desires; don't entertain them...flee (cf. 1 Corinthians 6:18).

5. WE FAIL TO STRENGTHEN WEAK AREAS.

The demands of life often tempt us to seek gratification in alcohol, gambling, gluttony, and so on. We must be on high alert. The enemy uses "opportune times" to draw us away from God (cf. Luke 4:13). The line is so thin that it is often hard to determine when we cross over. Weak areas such as drugs, alcohol, pain meds, sex, anger, marriage issues, and so on are "opportune times" for the enemy to strike. We must expose these areas through repentance, and install safeguards and accountability. To be forewarned is to be forearmed. (As a side note, depression and anxiety can work against us as well. Much can be done to safeguards these areas too. Read more here.

6. ACCOUNTABILITY IS OFTEN BREACHED OR MINIMIZED.

Accountability is a safeguard, but its not bulletproof. Accountability, by itself, doesn't work—it's not realistic to ask others to hold you accountable. Your heart must be focused on honoring God's Word. Accountability simply adds another level of security in the battle against sin. It's healthy to say to those we trust, "I'm struggling in this area. Can you pray with me and ask the hard questions from time to time." The enemy loves to work in darkness and deceit. Exposing cracks in the armour helps others keep an eye on them as well.

I also have accountability software that sends all websites visited to my wife's email every week. This is a major deterrent and it makes me very conscious of even seemingly innocent sites. To some, this may seem extreme, but we need to be armed for the enemy who steals, kills, and destroys. The greater our influence, the greater the need for accountability: spiritually, financially, and relationally.

7. LONELINESS BECOMES AN EXCUSE.

Ministry is hard and can easily take its toll. Feeling a sense of entitlement is often the beginning of justifying wrong choices. We can easily become jealous and judgmental of those who seem to have "all the fun." As Oswald Chambers states: "God buries His men [and women] in the midst of paltry things, no monuments are erected to them; they are ignored, not because they are unworthy, but because they are in the place where they cannot be seen."

Luke 16:10 should be a great encouragement, "So you also, when you have done everything you were told to do, should say, 'We are unworthy servants; we have only done our duty'." Sin can be silenced in a thankful heart set on worshiping God. God has given us the privilege to serve Him, proclaim His truth, and help others. Don't allow frustration and negativity to lead you down the wrong path.

In closing, if you are on the cliff or have already fallen, take time now and repent. It will hurt, but the fruit of repentance far outweighs the fruit of exposure that will surely come (cf. Numbers 32:23). God's grace will see you through. A penitent person turns from sin. They accept full responsibility for their actions without blame, resentment, or bitterness. They seek forgiveness without conditions and stipulations. They take full (not partial) responsibility for their actions. There can be no "but's" when repentance is genuine. "I am sorry. I was wrong. Please forgive me," are often (although not always) healing words and signs of repentance. Excuses need to stop before healing can occur.

There are consequences for past mistakes, but it's best to live in God's healing arms of forgiveness, rather than to live broken outside of His will. Which way will you turn?

New Florida Bill Will Require Public High Schools to Offer Classes on the Bible and Religion

Florida state legislators recently introduced a new bill that will require the school districts to offer classes on religion and the Bible in public high schools.

House Bill 195 was filed by Florida House Democrat Kimberly Daniel last week and requires "each school district to offer specified courses relating to religion, Hebrew Scriptures, and the Bible to certain students as elective courses."



ment of the Bible, and the New Testament of the Bible."

Along with the study of the Bible, the bill states that a "brief meditation period" will also be allotted for students.

The bill stresses that teachers teaching these courses will be required to approach the subject in an objective matter as to adhere to state and federal regulations, stating that all

teachers must maintain "religious neutrality and accommodating the diverse religious views, traditions, and perspectives of all students in the school.

Some of the suggested classes include a course on "Hebrew Scriptures and Old Testament of the Bible; a course on the New Testament of the Bible; and a course on the Hebrew Scriptures, the Old Testa-

Ark Encounter Founder Offers Free Admission to Public Schools after Atheist Group Threatens to Sue Schools Who Visit it

The Wisconsin-based atheist group, Freedom From Religion Foundation, warned public schools not to take their students to the Creation Museum or the Ark Encounter Park because of their "overtly religious atmosphere."

CBN News reports that the FFRF sent over 1,000 letters to school districts across the country, many of them in Ken-

It is unacceptable to expose a captive audience of impressionable students to the overtly religious atmosphere of (Ken) Ham's Christian theme parks."

Ham offered free admission to all public school teachers and students that come for "official public school trips."

He told Fox News, "The atheist groups like American Atheists

and the Freedom From Religion Foundation have been increasingly aggressive to restrict the free exercise of religion."

Pratt also shared his gratitude for the experience on Instagram. The movie star posted a collage of five photos, each featuring him spending time with a different kid. One photo shows Pratt sitting with Paige as the two played with Legos together, another shows Pratt kissing a baby, and yet another shows Pratt looking at what appears to be a drawing or a card done by one of the kids.

Chris Pratt says Christian faith is saving him from 'lion's den' of fame: 'It will kill you'

Actor Chris Pratt credits his Christian faith with saving him from Hollywood's "lion's den" of fame — a force, he said, that has the power to "kill" its victims.

During an interview on "The Late Show with Stephen Colbert," Pratt was asked: "Do you ever feel like you're in the lion's den by being a celebrity in the public eye?"

The actor responded with a quote from his pastor about the pressures of fame and struggle to maintain humility: "If the spotlight that is shining on you is brighter than the light that's within you, it will kill you."

"And you see it all the time," he said, calling stardom "a real bright spotlight."

"Sometimes just having a self to share is what kills you, because there's nothing left," Pratt continued. "So you have to have a light to share. A light that's just as bright as any of these lights. Then you can survive and then you can save some of yourself and not give it all away. It's true."

"The Lego Movie" actor also revealed that he has just completed a 21-day Daniel Fast that he participated in through his church. "Daniel was a guy who only ate fruits, vegetables and grains," explained Pratt, adding that he was inspired by his pastor to complete it.

Pratt has been linked to Zoe Church in Los Angeles, California, which is pastored by Chad Veach. According to the church's website, Veach and his congregation completed the Daniel Fast, and the pastor extensively documented his own experience on his Instagram page.

Pratt, who regularly uses his platform to share his faith, previously revealed that Veach's books have been helping him keep his faith strong. "I read books by my pastor, Chad Veach, in Zoe Church LA," he said in a home video posted in December. "I find his book Faith Forward Future to be very helpful!"

The 39-year-old actor recently announced his engagement to Katherine Schwarzenegger, declaring, "I'm thrilled to be marrying you. Proud to live boldly in faith with you. Here we go!"

The duo plans to have a "religious wedding" and want to keep God at the center of the marriage, according to People magazine.



"They're going to want a religious wedding," a source close to the couple said. "I know that Chris does, and I assume that she does too. God is going to be a part of this marriage."

The same source also added that Pratt appreciates how Schwarzenegger isn't afraid to discuss her beliefs openly. "He's constantly around other people who have no faith or are apologetic about it, but not her. She is willing to talk about it to anyone who will listen," the source said.

Another source told the magazine that the couple would wed soon, possibly in the upcoming summer months.

"They are one of those rare couples that you root for from the beginning. It won't be a long engagement — Katherine has already talked about having a summer 2019 wedding," the source said.

President Trump Quotes Jeremiah 1:5 in Defending Unborn Life at National Prayer Breakfast

President Trump on Thursday committed to helping protect faith-based adoption agencies and then quoted the book of Jeremiah in reaffirming his position on the unborn.

Trump's comments came at the National Prayer Breakfast, an annual event that brings together different religious groups and members from both parties. Every president since President Eisenhower has attended.

Trump discussed several issues, including anti-Semitism, human and sex trafficking, and religious

liberty, but his remarks about abortion received the loudest applause.

"As part of our commitment to building a just and loving society, we must build a culture that cherishes the dignity and sanctity of innocent human life," Trump said. "All children, born and unborn, are made in the holy image of God. Every life is sacred, and every soul is a precious gift from heaven.

"As the Lord says in Jeremiah, 'Before I formed you in the womb, I knew you before you were born. I set you apart," he added, quoting from Jeremiah 1:5.

To underscore his point, Trump recounted the story of a baby named Grayson that was born in the backseat of a car during a snowstorm four months premature, weighing only one pound, 11 ounces. Doctors were unsure if he would survive. The parents, Nikki and Tyler Watkinson, were in attendance at the prayer breakfast.



"Nikki and Tylor's entire community began to lift up Grayson in their prayers, and to the surprise of doctors he kept on improving, improving, improving," Trump said.

Grayson is now one year old.

"He is a beautiful happy, healthy guy," Trump said. "... Nikki said he was put on this earth to do big things. He may be here someday, right here, Nikki. He already has [done great things] and he will do more and more as he grows older."

Trump also discussed his administration's record on religious liberty: He appointed a special envoy to monitor and combat anti-Semitism recently. Imprisoned pastor Andrew Brunson was released from Turkey. The State Department is cutting off aid to nations that do not demonstrate a commitment to ending human trafficking.

Faith, Trump said, has been a positive force in the nation's history.

"Since the founding of our nation, many of our greatest strides – from gaining our independence, to abolition, [to] civil rights, to extending the vote for women – have been led by people of faith and started in prayer," he said. "When we open our hearts to faith, we fill our hearts with love. Many of the people in this room lead and support the charities and faith-based institutions that bring hope to the lives of our citizens, comfort to those in despair and solace to those in grief, aid to those in need and a helping hand to the struggling people all around the world."

500 Inmates Are Saved after Texas Megachurch Opens Campus in Maximum Security Prison

Gateway church announced last Sunday that they have opened up a new campus, and it's at a nearby prison.

According to Relevant Magazine, Lead pastor Robert Morris for Gateway megachurch in Dallas, Texas, announced during Sunday's service last week that a new campus had been planted at the Coffield Unit maximum security prison in Anderson County.

Fox News reports that 650 inmates attended the first Coffield Gateway service

in November and since then over 500 men have dedicated their lives to Jesus

"At Gateway Church, we're all about people because God is all about people," Morris told Fox News. "Many of the men and women inside prison have been forgotten by society, but we want them to know we love them and God loves them, and they are our brothers and sisters in Christ."

According to Fox News, the Coffield campus is set up to run like any other campus and gives inmates the opportunity to serve. In-



mates are tasked with greeting service attendees, being ushers, operating audio and visual equipment, forming a worship team, and staffing the service, the outlet reports.

The campus is pastored by Stephen Wilson who is an ex-offender. After getting out, Wilson turned his life around and went to seminary school which led him to share the gospel in prisons. Wilson told Fox that the plan for this ministry started seven years ago, and now it has finally

happened.

"If it wasn't for the ministry of Gateway, we probably wouldn't be experiencing some of the stuff we're experiencing right now," a Coffield Campus member shared.

In a video showing Morris' announcement of the new campus, Gateway parishioners are seen standing and applauding the ministry. Morris also announced that Gateway is planning to open more prison campuses in the near future.

Pro-Life Group to Show Live Third-Trimester Ultrasounds in Time Square



On a mission to show people that the unborn are human beings, Focus on the Family is taking to New York to displayed live ultrasounds on monitors and screens in Time Square.

According to CBN News, Focus on the Family – a global Christian ministry that works to help families thrive – is holding a live ultrasound viewing in response to New York's new Reproductive Health

Act and the proposed abortion bill in Virginia that would have allowed women to have an abortion while in labor.

In an interview with CBN News, Focus on the Family President Jim Daly said, "I think really what's happened in New York and in Virginia has prompted a response."

Daly also noted the comments made by Virginia's governor Ralph Northam which appeared to endorse infanticide.

The May 4 event will be filled with, speakers, music and 4-D footage of live third-trimester pregnancy ultrasounds.

Daly said, "And with the 4-D technology that we have, it looks like a picture of a 1-year-old."

"There is no way a person is going to be able to say, 'That is not a child.' It is a child and we want everybody to see it," he added.

Daly said his organization chose Time Square so that they can have an open dialogue with as many people as possible. He told CBN News, "Well, [Time Square's] the epicenter of everything. I think if you talk to anyone in Manhattan, Times Square is where it all happens. We're not shy about going there and saying to Governor Cuomo and others, 'Let's look."

He added, "This isn't adversarial. Let's just take a position. Let's see what an ultrasound looks like."

Daly also encouraged the Christian community not to be afraid to speak up on the issue of abortion noting that it is a "moral issue."

He said, "This is ancient Rome once again, and Christians were known for saving babies who were thrown out in the garbage heaps to die. That was their (Rome's) form of infanticide."

He concluded, "This isn't anything new, but it was the Christians that stood up and said 'No. Everyone human is made in God's image and we can't destroy innocent human beings."

Daly invites anyone and everyone to come and join him and the Focus on the Family team at their ultrasound education event on May 4 in Time Square.

Dozens of Missionaries Forced to Flee Haiti amid Growing Violence

Missionaries are being forced to leave Haiti amid growing violence in the country.

According to media reports, there have been riots in the country, calling for the resignation of President Jovenel Moise. CBN News reports that families have had to go into hiding and people are paying money to travel safely on the streets.

"There have been lots of demonstrations in Haiti over the past year. There are lots of people that are unhappy with the government and the way the president is doing things. It's just been escalating and building up," said Lisa Honorat, a missionary who has since fled the country.

"It was all over the country, not just in the city," she said. "There have been roadblocks and looting and burning tires, burning cars. If anyone tries to go out on the street, they will destroy your car. It's very dangerous."

"A man we talked to on the plane yesterday said he got through by driving but at every checkpoint, he had to pay between U.S. \$500 and \$5,000 just to get through."

James Roberts, vice president of Haiti Arise, says the riots and violence started when food and fuel depots were closed.

"People couldn't even buy food, if there was any available, because the money got devalued. So, we were starting to run out of food for all our people," he said.



Mission organization Dirt Road Project had plans to travel to Haiti to help with those food shortages and provide other aid, but the U.S. State Department has since ordered an evacuation of all non-emergency U.S. citizens in the country.

"The majority of the people in Haiti, if not all, are wonderful people and they deserve better," said April Benson, founder of the Dirt Road Project.

South Carolina Megachurch Donates \$50,000 to Pro-Life Pregnancy Resource Center



According to the Christian Post, Executive Director for the Women's Enrichment Center in Lancaster Julie Walters - who is a member of Transformation Church – joined Gray on stage during the announcement.



Gray said as he called her up on stage, "Julie and her team are right on the front lines of helping women and young men just make decisions to bring forth life."

"So we have partnered with her and her team for several years. Today, we the people at Transformation Church want to give you \$50,000 to continue to do the great work that you are doing. We appreciate you," he added as he gave Walters a hug.

According to the Christian Post, Walters says she was "blown away."

The Executive Director said, "When I tell you we were blown away, we were so blessed. I feel so humbled to be able to receive these funds. It helps us substantially with what we do."

"Having this kind of funds given to us is a tremendous blessing," she added

According to the WEC website, the center offers women facing unplanned pregnancy counseling, pregnancy and parenting education, vitals clinics, ultrasounds and employment and skills training. The center encourages its patients to consider parenting and adoption instead of abortion, but also provides post-abortion peer-counseling for women who had already decided to have an abortion.

Former Christian Rockstar Warns Today's Generation Not to Be Deceived by 'Popularity Gospel'

Singer Mattie Montgomery from popular Christian metalcore band "For Today," offered a word of caution about popularity gospel, something he says is today's generation's prosperity gospel.

In an interview with The Christian Post about his book Scary God: Introducing the Fear of the Lord to the Postmodern Church, Montgomery says that today's generation has lost what it means to fear God and instead live by a "fear of man" principle.

Montgomery said, "We have been taught — especially in our social media generation — that the most important thing you can be is popular. Your value as a person is defined primarily by the number of followers you have on social media, how many likes you get."

Montgomery goes on to note that in today's social media world, people place their identity and their worth in their retweets and Instagram likes. The singer even goes as far as to say that people have lost the concept of self and are marketing themselves like commodities online.

He said, "Because we market ourselves and packaged ourselves as a product to be sold, if we ever come to a place in our life where people aren't buying the product, we feel like an absolute failure. Ourselves, our individuality, our identity comes under attack."

The veteran singer then shared a comparison between prosperity gospel – which teaches that as your faith increases God rewards you with more wealth and better health – and social media popularity.

Montgomery said, "I have a friend who once said that if the primary deception of our parents' generation was the prosperity gospel, the primary deception of our generation is the popularity gospel."



He continued, "In our parent's generation, we were taught that the evidence of God's hand on someone's life or ministry was their financial prosperity — they had a lot of money."

"Similarly, in our generation, we are taught that the evidence of God's hand on someone's life or ministry is their popularity, how many people they are reaching, how many people come to their church and follow them on social media," he added.

Montgomery told The Christian Post that he wrote Scary God to explain to people what it really means to fear God, not what we want fearing God to mean.

He emphasized, "There is this misunderstanding that I think has crept into the Church that we would call the 'fear of the spirit of man' that has deceived us into believing that God's will for our lives is that we be popular or influential. The heroes and fathers of our faith, many of them could not have been described as popular or influential. But they were faithful and they feared God above all else."



Following in His Grandfather's Footsteps, Will Graham Shares the Gospel with 100,000 in the Philippines



Will Graham, the grandson of Dr. Billy Graham, preached the Gospel message to over 100,000 in the Philippines during his "evangelistic celebration," a crusade-style outreach across the globe, continuing the legacy of his grandfather through the Billy Graham Evangelistic Association.

Manila, the capital of the Philippines, holds special significance for the grandson, as

it is now the only place in the world to see three generations of the Graham family – Dr. Billy Graham, Frank Graham, and Will himself – preach to thousands gathered in the Quirino Grandstand, where millions of Filipinos have been led to Christ, reports CBN News. At this particular event, tens of thousands responded to the altar call.

The date of the event took place only days before the first-year anniversary of Billy Graham's death, leading Will Graham to recall his grandfather's influence and legacy, and what it means to continue in the work God began through his grandfather's life.

"I wish I could go back and tell my grandfather what I did in Manila. 'Oh Daddy Billy, you won't believe it. I preached in the same place you preached in 1977 in Manila.' I don't have that anymore," he said. "I miss that part."

In 1957, Luz Alvarez, now 84 years old, listened to the message spoken by Dr. Billy Graham during his crusade 62 years ago.

"I can still remember it was raining hard because there was a storm that night in 1957," she told CBN News. "But many people still came, as many as the people who are here tonight. I am so happy that now I am listening to his grandson. They are a big blessing to the Philippines." Many years later, Alvarez served as a counselor for Will Graham's Celebration.

The events came during a season of political unrest. Local and national elections will take place in May, and the country has already experienced politically motivated violence, and deadly some bombings in the south, where 20 were killed in church bombing.

Will Graham, however, emphasized that during times like these, "I think it's even more imperative to preach the Gospel," he said. "The only thing that can change people's lives is the Gospel."

"This is the only message we know what to preach, the power of God unto salvation," said Will. "And that's what my grandfather preaches, my father has preached, and that's what I will continue to preach wherever I go."

Ebola Treatment Center Now Open in the Democratic Republic of the Congo

Samaritan's Purse opened an 18-bed Ebola treatment center in Komanda in northeast Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC) on Jan. 17.

Medical teams are ensuring the comfort and expert care of every patient as they serve in Jesus' Name.

"By coming to treat people with this difficult disease, we as Christians are showing God's love and concern for them," said Elliott Tenpenny, director of our international health unit and team lead in the DRC.



received extensive training in infection protection and control and donning their personal protective equipment.

"When I see my fellow Congolese people suffering from Ebola, I am sad, but it challenges me to help them so that one day they will recover and be strong," said Sarah Ngaka, one of our local staff.

More than 300 people have died since this Ebola outbreak was declared Aug. 1, making it the second deadliest surge of the disease in recorded history. Supportive care and other interventions are saving lives, though the current fatality rate is still about 60 percent.


Our treatment center, which can be expanded to 54 beds if needed, was constructed and properly equipped for water and sanitation over the span of about two weeks. Patients are cared for in the isolation unit until lab results indicate whether they have been infected with Ebola.


The center is part of our Emergency Field Hospital and was flown to Africa by our DC-8 cargo plane. We have more than 40 medical and non-medical staff on the ground and more than 60 Congolese staff have also been hired from local communities. All our staff have
