

The Local Church

There is only one reason for people coming together in a local church, and that of course is the person of Jesus Christ. Each believer has placed their faith in Christ as Savior believing that their sins are fully paid for by the sacrificial work of God's Son Jesus Christ. As a result of our faith, we have been made members of His body, the church, and members of one another. Each believer has the new birth and the Holy Spirit. Nevertheless, as people who have all experienced the wonder of salvation, there can be a difference in growth, temptations, experiences, backgrounds and cultures. We each have brought some things from our past in Christ. When we enter a Christian fellowship, we learn that each person is in the process of spiritual growth. Jesus is working and all are, in one way or another, be- John Duckhorn ing conformed to His Image as He sees fit.



The New Testament epistles have instructions on how we should treat one another or how we should not treat them. The "one another" verses are spread throughout the epistles. Romans 14 and 15 instruct us about a common problem of acceptance of another true believer in Christ. Romans 14:1 says, "As for those who are weak in faith, welcome them, but not to quarrel over opinions." Romans 15:1 says: "We who are strong have an obligation to bear with the failings of the weak and not to please ourselves." Each believer is seeking to grow in the faith and is aware of certain dangers of sin in their own experience. They often build warning fences in order to avoid falling into sin. These fences are really nothing but signals that we are getting too close to the borders of sin.

The tension arises because the fences we put up are not all built in the same way for each believer. Instead of sin they were meant to guard against, the fence becomes the issue. Paul calls these "doubtful." They are doubtful to us and we feel we must not go against our conviction. Too often though, we want to make sure that others hold on to all of our personal convictions. Others are too sensitive and do not have a lot of freedom in some areas. The Weak person is not clear as to whether an action is wrong or right and is incapable of forming sound judgement. Those who are strong can show contempt for the "legal" conscience of the Weak person, and the Weak person can judge the freedom of the "strong" as unspiritual.

Paul gives some valuable guidelines for dealing with this subject:

- 1. A weak person should be received into fellowship without arguing over his scruples.
- Mutual forbearance is to be shown. Vs 3
- 3. Every believer is a servant of the Lord. The Lord is able to make that person stand. Vs 4
- 4. Instead of bickering over inconsequential matters, we should make every effort to maintain peace. Vs 9
- 5. Live to please your neighbor, to do good. This is the Christian Approach. Vs 15:12
- 6. In spite of any difference that might exist concerning secondary matters, we should "receive one another just as Christ also received us." Vs 15:7

If we will put into action these simple instructions from Paul, we will have churches where growth is encouraged and people will be free to grow at the rate God planned for them. Remember the real issue is whether the person is making Jesus Christ Lord of his or her life.

In Touch Ministries Celebrates 45 Years of God's Faithfulness

In 1972, Stanley launched his television ministry "The Chapel Hour," a half-hour, Atlanta-area program that aired on WXIA-TV 11 and WANX 46. From this foundation, Stanley founded In Touch Ministries in 1977. The Christian Broadcasting Network (CBN), impressed by the young pastor's abilities and seeking a practical Bible teaching program, contacted Stanley in 1978 in order to include the program in a satellite distribution network for cable systems. Within a week, the broadcast began to attract a national audience.

To this day, "In Touch with Dr. Charles Stanley" can be heard worldwide with programs in more than 50 languages and 2,600 radio and television outlets. In Touch Ministries was founded to "lead people worldwide into a growing relationship with Jesus Christ." While Stanley stepped down as senior pastor at First Baptist Church Atlanta in 2020 to focus on In Touch Ministries, his sermons continue to be broadcast globally. Stanley's Bible teaching provides listeners with Christ-centered principles for everyday life.

Through its Messenger Lab technology collective, In Touch has utilized a collection of solar-powered and digital devices to provide villages and remote areas with the gospel since 2007. In Touch has reached those with limited access to electricity and online media with flagship devices such as the "Messenger," a handheld media player that is pre-loaded with Stanley's signature sermons and Scripture in 100+ different languages. Other versions of the device include a built-in flashlight, FM receiver, and other features customized for the intended use case. The Messenger Lab collection includes other devices such as USBs, micro SDs, tablets with libraries full of Dr. Stanley's Life Principles training, and more.

In addition to digital resources, In Touch offers discipleship and leadership training through their Life Principles Conferences for local pastors and church leaders who may not have access to formal train-

ing. Conference locations include Uganda, Ecuador, Kenya, Chile, Egypt, Tanzania, Zambia, Bolivia, South Sudan, India, Brazil, Peru, Belize, and more.

In Touch Ministries has been an NRB member since 1980 and is the 1983 recipient of the Award of Merit, 1999 Radio Program of the Year, 2014 Billy Graham Award for Excellence in Communication, and many other awards. In 1988, Stanley was inducted into the NRB Hall of Fame, which is NRB's most prestigious award "for invaluable contribution to the field of Christian communications, exhibition of the highest standards and evidence of faithfulness in Christ."

Stanley is also the 2020 recipient of the NRB Chairman's Award, has spoken at NRB Conventions on multiple occasions over the years, and is a former member of the NRB Board of Directors.

"Over the years, In Touch has taken an innovative approach to sharing the gospel through every electronic medium," said NRB CEO Troy A. Miller. "Under Dr. Stanley's mission-focused leadership, In Touch is a mainstay of timeless, trustworthy Bible teaching and pastoral training all over the globe."

NRB congratulates In Touch Ministries on this milestone and recognizes Dr. Stanley for his distinctive service in Christian communications and ministry.

9-Year-Old Ellie Garcia Shared the Gospel Before She Was Killed By Uvalde School Shooter

Ellie Garcia, one of the 19 children killed by a teenager at Robb Elementary School in Texas last week, would pray every night out loud and shared the Gospel on social media before she died about a week before her 10th birthday.

Garcia, a 9-year-old victim of Tuesday's mass shooting at the school in Uvalde, had posted a TikTok video, saying: "Hey, guys. I just wanted to give you a little catch-up. Jesus. He died for us. So when we die, we'll be up there with Him. In my room, I have three pictures of Him."

Her father, Steven Garcia, posted the 15-second video on Facebook.

Garcia also shared how his daughter loved to pray. He shared a photo that he took in January of his young daughter laying on her bed with her hands folded in prayer.

"Caught my Ellie Gee in the middle of her talk with our almighty ... I love you baby girl and I love the way you pray," he wrote at the time.

"She prayed every night out loud so we can pray with her," Garcia added. "I remember this day we had just bought the lamp that is on and she wanted to sleep with it on so she aired up her air mattress gave Us a hug and kiss and went to pray as mom made treats in the kitchen! These memories are all I have left."

A GoFundMe page for the Garcia family has raised \$128,078

raised \$128,078 of the \$50,000 goal as of Monday morning.

"She was born June 4th. This coming week she was going to be turning 10 years old," it says of Ellie. "Eliahna was such a sweet girl with a lovely and beautiful soul. She would light up everyone's world with big smiles & big hugs."

It adds, "She will never be forgotten we will always remember our ramen noodle girl forever! We appreciate all of our family, friends, surrounding communities and everyone across the world for all the love & prayers our



family has been receiving."

Texas Gov. Greg Abbott has assured, "We're not going to be here talking about it and do nothing about it. We will be looking for the best laws we can get passed to make communities safe."

In a column for The Christian Post reflecting on the shooting, Greg Laurie, the pastor and founder of the Harvest churches in California, stressed that "this is a time to mourn."

"The key is to cry out to God Himself," he wrote. "He will hear your prayer. If you are one of the parents who lost one of these children and is reading this right now, let me say this to you — I am so sorry for your loss."

He added, "If you have put your faith in Jesus Christ as your Lord and Savior you will see your child again. They are not just a part of your past, they are also a part of your future."



Will America Remain Virtuous Enough to Be Free?

John Adams, who would soon surrender the presidency to Thomas Jefferson, ventured up to Capitol Hill on Nov. 22, 1800, to deliver the first-ever in-person presidential address in the not-yet-finished home of the United States Congress.

It was noon on a Saturday. What message did he deliver?

First, Adams congratulated the American people for building the Capitol itself.

"I congratulate the people of the United States on the assembling of Congress at the permanent seat of

their government, and I congratulate you, gentlemen, on the prospect of a residence not to be changed," he said. "Although there is cause to apprehend that accommodations are not now so complete as might be wished, yet there is great reason to believe that this inconvenience will cease with the present session."

Then Adams pointed to morality, religion and God.

"It would be unbecoming the representatives of this nation to assemble for the first time in this solemn temple without looking up to the Supreme Ruler of the universe and imploring His blessing," he said.

"May this territory be the residence of virtue and happiness!" said Adams. "In this city may that piety and virtue, that wisdom and magnanimity, that constancy and self-government, which adorned the great character whose name it bears be forever held in veneration! Here and throughout our country may simple manners, pure morals, and true religion flourish forever!"

This was not a new theme for the nation's second president or for his contemporaries.

In 1778, while serving the newly independent United States as a commissioner to France, Adams passed by a mansion called Bellevue that King Louis XV had built as a residence for his mistress, Madame de Pompadour.

Adams came to view this estate as a symbol of the depravity of the French monarchy.

"I asked some questions about this place," Adams wrote in his diary on June 2, 1778, "and was informed that it was called Bellevue and was the residence of the Kings Aunts Adelaide and (Victoire), two of the surviving daughters of Louis the fifteenth. That this palace had been built and this establishment made by that monarch for Madame Pompadour, whom he visited here, almost every night for twenty years, leaving a worthy woman his virtuous Queen alone at Versailles..."

"The foundations of national morality must be laid in private families," Adams went on to say in this same diary entry.



"In vain are schools, accademies, and universities instituted, if loose principles and licentious habits are impressed upon children in their earliest years," he said. "The mothers are the earliest and most important instructors of youth ... The vices and examples of the parents cannot be concealed from the children. How is it possible that children can have any just sense of the sacred obligations of morality and religion if, from their earliest infancy, they learn that their mothers live in habitual infidelity to their fathers, and their fathers in as constant infidelity to their mothers."

On June 21, 1776, while serving in the Second Continental Congress, which would soon pass the Declaration of Independence, Adams responded to a letter from his cousin Zabdiel Adams, who, according to the Massachusetts Historical Society, was a Christian clergyman.

"Statesmen my dear sir, may plan and speculate for liberty, but it is religion and morality alone, which can establish the principles upon which freedom can securely stand," wrote Adams.

"The only foundation of a free constitution, is pure virtue, and if this cannot be inspired into our people, in a greater measure, than they have it now, they may change their rulers, and the forms of government, but they will not obtain a lasting liberty. They will only exchange tyrants and tyrannies," he said.

"You cannot therefore be more pleasantly, or usefully employed than in the way of your profession, pulling down the strong holds of Satan," Adams told his cousin. "This is not cant, but the real sentiment of my heart."

Twenty-two years later, when he was president of the United States, Adams delivered the same message to the Massachusetts militia.

"We have no government armed with power capable of contending with human passions unbridled by ... morality and religion," said President Adams. "Avarice, ambition (and) revenge or galantry, would break the strongest cords of our Constitution as a whale goes through a net.

"Our Constitution was made only for a moral and religious people," he said. "It is wholly inadequate to the government of any other."

What would John Adams think if he were told about the recent mass murders in Buffalo, New York, and Uvalde, Texas? Would he think they were manifestations of a gun problem in America or a moral problem?

To pass the American tradition of freedom down to future generations we must also pass down the moral and religious foundations needed to sustain it.

God Is Unifying Body of Christ In Ministry To LGBT People, Freedom March Leaders Say

Declaring their testimonies of how Jesus has transformed their lives, formerly LGBT-identified young men and women gathered in Washington, D.C., Saturday for the Freedom March.

Gathered at the Sylvan Theater next to the Washington Monument for what has become an annual event in the nation's capital, the hosts of the march continue to see the Holy Spirit doing remarkable work in the lives of people who reach out to them.

Under mostly cloudy skies Saturday af-

ternoon, Luis Javier Ruiz, a co-founder of the Freedom March and a survivor of the 2016 terrorist attack at the Pulse gay nightclub, recounted how the National Park Service had double-booked the Freedom March with another group called the Foundation for Creative Cultural Expression, an LGBT pride group. Though the double-booking was an accident on the part of the Park Service, Ruiz regarded it as a strategic God-move.

"A group of overcomers, free from the LGBT identity, now coming into a place where everybody here was for gay pride. I just love seeing the hand of God. Sometimes church is just too churched. This is part of evangelism, to bring people out so everyone can hear the Gospel," Ruiz said in an interview with The Christian Post.

Live-streamed online to thousands and attended by 100 people, the ecumenical Christian event featured joyous worship music, prayer and the declaration of testimonies from those who once lived and identified as LGBT. Some described traumatic experiences from childhood and wounds from relationships that contributed to confusion about their bodies and sexuality. One man who shared from the podium described how he was sexually abused as a young child and was even trafficked. Through Christ, he was able to transform his life and he's now married to a woman.

Though statistics from reputable surveys have shown that many young people have fallen away from their faith — what some call "The Great Falling Away" — Ruiz believes God continues to be at work, drawing people into His family.

"What I love about this is that there are Baptists, Pentecostals, Catholics, all types of people coming together in the name of Jesus, saying that change is not only possible, but it's real through Jesus. I get excited when I see an Adventist brother, a Church of God brother ... it brings me so much joy to how the Lord is unifying the Body of Christ."

Jeffrey McCall, who founded the Freedom March, said he's amazed by how the Lord is stirring among younger people. Since 2018, when the first march took place, their growing tribe of formerly LGBTidentified people has become especially close.

"We call each other, do Bible studies together, encourage each other \dots it has built a family, and it's a young family," McCall told CP.



McCall, who once lived as a transidentified person named Scarlet and led a promiscuous homosexual lifestyle before encountering the Holy Spirit, said after he found Christ, he threw all of his women's clothing and makeup into a dumpster. In the past five years, he's observed how transgenderism and "gender identity" has consumed nearly everything, even among the LGBT groups. But he believes God is moving supernaturally and changing the minds of people.

"We were warned thousands of years ago [in Scripture] that the world is going to get darker, and so we have to be that light," McCall said.

He added that while praying, he sensed God speak to Him about how the enemy mobilizes large groups to carry out his will, but the Lord can use a small remnant of people to execute His plans.

Sharing the story of Gideon, whose army of 300 men defeated the Midianites in the book of Judges, he said of the Freedom March: "We're a small remnant doing the Lord's will."

Kim Zember, a board member of Freedom March, senses that the Holy Spirit has been drawing more people to hear about how Christ has transformed them and said churches are starting to do a better job of reaching people who identify as LGBT.

"As confusion is spreading throughout the nation and the world, not just within the LGBT community, but really just as a whole, people are seeking."

Asked to describe what she sees God doing among the LGBT community and the Freedom March tribe, she replied: "To love His children back to His heart."

She believes that a later shift has taken place within many churches. Until recently, Zember recounted that the moment she went to a church she was going to be told that what she was doing was wrong. "But I already knew that, but how do I walk this out? I've seen a massive growth within the Church desiring to be taught too. Leaders are saying: 'Can you help us?'"

"This is not rewriting the Bible," she assured. "This is 'How can we walk with you?' The Scripture says to bear one another's burdens, not fix one another's burdens. And so the Church is learning to bear one another's burdens as we learn to do the same. That's never celebrating sin, that's never condoning sin. It's bearing burdens because we know that when there is a heaviness that comes we're supposed to bear that together."

McCall has long said that the march was partly inspired by the passage in Colossians 2:15 wherein the Apostle Paul explained how Jesus "made a public spectacle of [the demonic powers and principalities], triumphing over them by the cross." In that same vein, following the worship and testimonies from the stage, those gathered marched from the Sylvan Theater and looped the reflecting pool near the Lincoln Memorial.



After talking with their financial advisor, and consulting with us at National Christian Foundation Wisconsin (NCF WI), they picked one of their parcels of land as the perfect candidate to fund charity. The land was bought in 1940 and appreciated in value to nearly \$500,000. They never predicted such wealth.

By donating the farm to their Giving Fund at NCF before they sold it, they were able to take a deduction on their taxes for the fair market value of the gift. The impact was significant. There was a tax savings of almost \$200,000. Charity received the full proceeds, which were not affected by taxes. Federal Agencies Celebrate Pride, Ignore Memorial Day

If you're wondering where America's heroes rank on Joe Biden's list of priorities, try below the rainbow flag. While federal agencies have been tripping over themselves to pledge allegiance to LGBT activism, two couldn't be bothered to recognize the fallen troops who make our freedom possible. Despite a government-wide tweet-fest over Pride Month, the Departments of Justice and Treasurymanaged to ignore Memorial Day altogether.

Thanks to social media, Americans are getting a good look at the main obsession of this administration, which has devoted more than 30 posts to LGBT extremism from their official accounts — but couldn't spare half that attention to the men and women who gave all. Treasury Secretary Janet Yellen, who was probably too busy promoting abortion as the solution to our tanking economy, failed to mark either occasion. U.S. Attorney General Merrick Garland's team, on the other hand, showed complete disregard for our military by celebrating pride but overlooking Americans' ultimate sacrifice.

Family Research Council's executive vice president, Lt. General (Ret.) Jerry Boykin could only shake his head at the administration's tunnel vision. "It's astounding that any government agency would refuse to acknowledge and honor the military men and women who died fighting for this country. We see this administration setting aside an entire month to recognize and celebrate with the LGBT community, while at the same time, we have a large number of homeless veterans and others with severe disabilities and PTSD. When are we going to set aside a designated period of time to help them?"

Elsewhere, the taxpayer-funded revelry goes on. And not just through June. With gas prices soaring, U.S. Energy officials want Americans to know they're hard at work pumping out — diversity. "Pride. This month. Next month. Always," the office posted to social media. An angry stream of responses followed. "So comforting to know that you've invested your time and effort into this nonsense when the Secretary of Energy doesn't even know how much oil the U.S. consumes daily and Americans are paying the highest prices ever for fuel," one frustrated American fired back. "Now if only we could celebrate any of you doing your job well," another said.

At Health and Human Services, where Secretary Xavier Becerra is on a personal crusade to fund children's transition surgeries with taxpayer dollars, the agency released a novella on pride — devoting 1,600 words to the cause and offering 15 separate statements from HHS leaders (including Rachel Levine). Not to be outdone, Education officials decided to change their government seal to the "prog-

ress pride" flag, paying special homage to transgenderism — while the Marines, Air Force, and Space Force hyped everything from rainbow bullets to astronauts "queering" the moon.

Meanwhile, at Agriculture, the occasion eclipsed even National Dairy Month, as banners, logos, and around-the-clock tweets spewed politically correct sexualism. And while the USDA did put up a good fight with its rainbow-colored produce backdrop, the award for LGBT pandering has to go to the U.S. State Department, which — apart from posting more pride tweets than anyone in government over a 24-hour span — also managed to enrage the world's religious community with its stunt at the Holy See. The jarring site of the U.S. embassy, just steps from the Vatican, waving the LGBT flag felt like just the latest middle finger from Biden to people of faith.

Like so many, Family Research Council's Connor Semelsberger, director of Federal Affairs, is horrified by the display and its undercurrent of hostility to religion as a whole. "The Catholic Church's teachings on the beauty of natural marriage and human sexuality have been known for millennium. This move by the U.S. embassy to fly a 'pride flag' at the Holy See reveals that the radical LGBT agenda is a pseudo religion that seeks to replace the moral and social teachings of the tradition of the Catholic faith and enforce its rule on all major institutions around the world."

After its Twitter post showcasing the story-high flag, the U.S. was blasted for its hypocrisy. "The Biden administration would never do this in an Islamic country," Ben Shapiro argued. "This is anti-Catholic bigotry." And ironically, it comes at the hands of a self-professed Catholic, Joe Biden. Mary Szoch, Family Research Council's director for the Center of Dignity insists it's just one in a long line of betrayals to his faith. "The U.S. Embassy to the Holy See's decision to fly a rainbow flag is consistent with President Biden's clear lack of respect for Catholic teaching. ... Since his inauguration, President Biden, who calls himself a devout Catholic, has openly supported policies that actively attack the heart of the family. He has pledged allegiance to the wrong flag."

Imagine being a Gold Star family — maybe one of the 13 who lost loved ones to Biden's disastrous Afghanistan withdrawal — watching this government-wide gaiety unfold. Your son or daughter, husband or wife, mother or father is gone, and the only thing this White House cares about is giving the full-measure of devotion to a vulgar fringe that mocks truth, bullies faith, and divides the nation. They are the few, the inexplicably proud.



intrinsic value and dignity (Genesis 1:27; 1 Corinthians 11:7a). Moreover, human life begins at conception—as Scripture tells us, "You knit me together in my mother's womb,"—and every person is "fearfully and wonderfully made" by Him (Psalm 139:13-16);

Whereas nearly one million pregnancies are terminated every year in the United States,



Whereas a pending Supreme Court decision in the case of Dobbs v. Jackson Women's Health Organization could overturn Roe v. Wade, which would mark a historic turning point in the fight for unborn life:

Youth For Christ Raises Over \$169K To Help Staff Displaced in War-Ravaged Ukraine

The parachurch ministry organization Youth For Christ has raised nearly \$170,000 to help support staff and volunteers who were forced to flee their homes amid Russia's invasion of Ukraine.

YFC volunteers, staff and others have donated, as of April 4, a little over \$169,500 to help 75 people associated with Youth For Christ Ukraine who were driven from their homes.

Joe Beckler, director of communications and change management at YFC, told The Christian Post on Monday that the funds will "be sent to YFC International's European regional office for distribution, oversight and stewardship."

The "initial goal," according to Beckler, was to raise \$135,000, which would support 75 people over three months, with the "understanding that \$20 per day provides food and shelter for one YFC Ukraine staff or volunteer who is displaced in Slovakia."

"We made an appeal to all staff, volunteers and giving partners across the United States. Their generosity was remarkable. As of April 4, we've raised \$169,615.50, and the gifts continue to come in," said Beckler.

In addition to financially supporting the displaced personnel, Beckler told CP that they hope to use some of the funds to later re-

build their ministry efforts in the Eastern European nation.

Beckler spoke highly of Youth For Christ Ukraine, explaining that the ministry group "has a faithful history of providing services to children and youth."

"Their ministry includes several teen centers in the capital city, where youth come for safety, meals, fellowship, and support through trauma," he continued.

"A few days into the invasion of Ukraine, we began to receive reports regarding our YFC Ukraine team. We were concerned and eager to provide any support possible. We consider all YFC teams, across the globe, as family and were eager to lean in and help."

Beckler hoped that "others would join us in praying for peace and protection in Eastern Europe. While the world is caught up in crisis, we are confident that our hope remains solely in Jesus Christ."

Since Russian forces invaded Ukraine in late February, many churches and ministries in



the United States have sought to help those directly affected by the conflict.

Gateway Church, a multisite megachurch based in Texas, recently helped relocate around 400 Ukrainian refugees through cooperation with ministry partners in the country.

"God loves and has not forgotten about the people of Ukraine," said Lawrence Swicegood, spokesperson for Gateway, in an earlier interview with CP. "We believe as Christians that we should be proactive in helping people in their time of need."

"War has devastated so many, but it has not crushed the spirit and hope of Ukrainian people."

It's Time to Get Our Crop Together!

I loved growing up on a farm—it was the work I hated. It didn't pay very well. One day, at about seventeen-years-stupid, I went to my father to inform him that in my humble-but-deadly accurate opinion my salary of \$60 per month was way too low. As a matter of fact the math showed that my wage came to a meager 17 1/2 cents-an-hour.

My dad did not need time to deliver his verdict on my wage claim. He smiled, and without hesitation said, "Son, I didn't realize that you're overpaid-you're fired!" After reflection, I had to admit that he was probably right. I didn't always have my crop together, which was kind of like saying that before the Titanic went down it had just a leak.

Many years after I left the farm, I eventually got a bit more of my crop more together, and by the grace of God, I came to a saving knowledge of Jesus Christ and wrote my first book: Leap of Faith: God Must Be a Packer Fan and today, The Peanut Butter Promise: Spreading Hope to Fulfill Your Purpose! of which I glean the suggestions in this story.

From my experience and work on the farm (and I use the word work loosely), I would like to share my "7 Keys to Getting Our Crop Together" that I use to challenge me every day-and may they do the same for you and of course through the power of the Holy Spirit who is always willing to help us (Romans 8:26).

1) Am I Willing to Take Honest Inventory of my Crop? In other words, where am I really at-not where I wish I was? What's on our inventory list? How about our emotions and overall character? How about our spiritual, mental, physical and literal bank accounts are a few others to ponder under our inven-

2) Am I Willing to Take Total Responsibility for my Crop? A huge step to healing comes for me-for us-when we take 100% responsibility for our life. I personally find many answers to my struggles in what I call "my problem finder"—it's called a mirror. Ultimately, we are all accountable and responsible to God for our own actions (Hebrew 4:13-16).

3) What Kind of Seed am I Planting in my Field? Each year Charlene and I watch the neighbors planting seed in their field. If they plant corn they get corn. If they plant wheat they get wheat. We all will reap what we have sown. In the same regard, if we plant positive thoughts we will get better effects than if we do the opposite, so let's plant good seed.

4) Do I Have the Right People Helping Me with my Crop? Associations are everything. Isn't it both interesting that we will attract people into our life based on what is right or wrong with us? So let's pray we can get our crop together and have associations with the right people. We are reminded that bad company corrupts good morals (Proverbs

5) Am I Willing to Share Some of My Crop with Being Others? human, we all like to hold on as too tightly to Steve Rose



our "stuff." Let us share some of our crop with others and watch the abundance of that giving. It is a comfort to know the Lord will always take care of our needs, not our "greeds" (Philippians 4:19).

6) Am I Willing to Fix Any Equipment in Need of Repair? Ouch. This one hits home for me as I feel the effects of winter on "my temple." Our bodies are just one area we need to provide constant maintenance to along with our spiritual, emotional and mental equipment we have that needs a regular tune up (I Corinthians 6:19-20).

7) What Kind of Crop Do I Want to Leave Behind? 



THE SCHOLAR'S CORNER: The Word

An Irish song I learned as a child!

"The Bible is God's telephone, Bringing messages down from the throne, To wee boys and girls of great heavenly joys; The Bible is God's telephone."

In subsequent studies we will reflect on the revealed Word of God and experience afresh the treasure which has been given to us in the inspired oracles and the plethora of blessings and advantages which are ours when we pursue its sacred pages. It is sad that today, even in Bible based churches, there appears to be less and less focus on and appreciate of Bible studies. Fewer and fewer Christians, to take one example, appear to have an intimate knowledge of the stages and scope of God's program for Israel and the world. Without an awareness of the significant difference between the hope of Israel and that of the Church, which is the Body of Christ, it will be very difficult to understand the revelation which has been given to us by God.

Every word in the divine oracles is inspired and had been breathed out by God. Every statement in Scripture is not necessarily inspired but the record of it is. For example, when the devil tempted Jesus, his actual words were not inspired but the record of what exactly he said is inspired. We must also keep in mind that not all translation are flawless but God's inspired Word as recorded in the original manuscripts came directly from God and nothing can change it.

THE SCRIPTURES WILL PROVIDE A FOUNDATION.

To become established in the Word is the only way we will ever be able to continue to grow towards spiritual maturity. Saturation in the inspired oracles will guarantee spiritual maturation, even though we have all experienced that there will be frequent bumps in the road. As healthy growth in the physical dimension is the prerequisite to reaching manhood, so in the spiritual life knowledge of The Word and the Imago Dei will eventuate in the ascription of glory to my Father-God.

As a believer there is a perennial onus on me to concentrate more and more on The Word because it gives a plethora of spiritual benefits. Six personal things that can happen when we open the Word:

- 1. I experience security
- 2. I am encouraged
- 3. I am given joy
- 4. I experience hope
- 5. I am given Guidance
- 6. I experience healing

Today many believers appear to suffer from spiritual attention deficit disorder when they approach Bible Study. They are disorganized, lack concentration and focus. Admittedly a lot of scripture is difficult to understand but we have been promised the Divine Teacher, who will walk beside us through the sacred pages and explain God's thoughts and intentions for us and its application to our daily lives. The Bible is a unique tool in that the more I use it the more it will become new and fresh to me.

As I approach this venture of Bible study I must be careful to read the instructions. There are questions I must ask, such as:

- What is the address on the envelope or to whom was it written?
- When was it written?
- By whom was it written?
- Why was it written?

and in particular why did God choose the particular and specific words used in the text? Our God is polylingual and therefore there must be a particular reason for every word used in the original inspired manuscript. A simple example may clarify. Paul, writing to the Ephesian Assembly enunciates the immortal words, "by {and in grace} grace are ve saved" (2:5). We appreciate the basic principle of the Gospel, namely, that nothing that I can ever do or accomplish will count towards my salvation and life in Christ. "Nothing in my hands I bring, simply to they cross I cling." My salvation is a God-given gratuity, based on The Cross and which I can never earn by my own good works or religious affiliation or practices. However, the Ephesian text also communicates the truth that my salvation is "in grace", which is different from being saved "by grace." It is a wonderful and awesome thought that there was something we were "in," even before the 'foundation' of the world, that was not something recently experienced. My salvation is not merely a gift from God but a 'gushing' of a lavish grace upon me even before the universe was created. I was never an after-thought in the mind of God!

Another pertinent example involves the Sabbath. In Leviticus I learn that I cannot observe the Sabbath Day without also obeying the Sabbath year. "But in the seventh year shall be a Sabbath of rest unto the land, a Sabbath for the Lord; thou shalt neither sow thy field nor prune thy vineyard." (Leviticus 25:4) This was not addressed to me as a member of the Body of Christ and this issue is exegeted very clearly in Paul's letter to the Galations. I do not have the option of obeying one instruction and ignoring the other. I must keep in mind to whom the words were written and why! The significant difference between exegesis, discovering what is inherent in the text, and eisegesis, what I inject into the text based on my personal desires and biases, must always be my concern.

Another example of the overall framework of the scripture to which I must be sensitive is seen in the very first verse of Genesis. "In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth." (Genesis 1:1) I find it fascinating that after this initial statement little mention is made about the heavens in the Hebrew Scriptures. The focus of the narrative in the Hebrew Oracles is on the earth, a message which will be radically different when we, for example, come to the Ephesian letter.

The Earthly: "And hath made of one blood all nations of men for to dwell on the face of the earth, and hath determined the times before appointed, and the bounds of their habitation." Acts 17:26 The Heavenly: "Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with all spiritual blessings in heavenly places in christ, Ephesians 1:3

It was to Israel that God gave the covenants, the sonship, the divine service and thee promise of an earthly kingdom. God, however, had also promised that He was going to call out a people from all nations that would be The Body of Christ and which would reign in the heavens making known the multifarious wisdom of God. This revelation cannot be found in the Hebrew scriptures. This hidden secret or mystery was given to Paul after the rejection by Israel of the heavenlies or the metaphysical dimension which was the promised focus of the church and which is described in Ephesians and which was a secret or mystery hidden in God!

These are issues which will be understood only with intensive and persistent study of God's Word.

Let us mention another example which may measure the intensity and seriousness of our Bible study. We are all familiar with the narrative of Luke incorrectly entitled "The Acts of the Apostles." After all only three of the original twelve apostles appear in the narrative, namely, Peter, James and John, and the latter two have minuscule mention. Luke in his historical narrative records the Acts of the Holy Spirit through the agency of Peter and Paul, who both continued to do and to teach all Jesus had taught and prac-

ticed. {Acts 1:1} Rarely is Peter mentioned again after the story of the conversion of Cornelius. Careful consideration of the text is life giving.

When you need encouragement, open the Book as we hope to do in future articles.

Pro-"Choice" Lawmakers Urge Google to Suppress Information About Pro-Life Options

Pro-life resource centers have been in the crosshairs of pro-abortion activist groups since the May leak of the draft Supreme Court decision in Dobbs v. Jackson and the subsequent overturn of Roe. Violent attacks and vandalism have become a daily threat. But rather than denounce the uncivil treatment of charitable groups, pro-abortion lawmakers are urging Google to remove information about crisis pregnancy centers from Google Search, Google Ads, and Google Maps—obscuring legitimate resources and information from view of those in crisis.

On June 17, over twenty House and Senate Democrats called on Google's top executive, Sundar Pichai, to limit search engine results featuring crisis pregnancy centers ("CPCs"), or what lawmakers referred to as "fake clinics," due to the centers' non-provision of abortion procedures.

In a letter to Pichai, spearheaded by Sen. Mark R. Warner (D¬–VA) and Rep. Elissa Slotkin (D¬–MI), lawmakers wrote: "Directing women towards fake clinics that traffic in misinformation and don't provide comprehensive health services is dangerous to women's health and undermines the integrity of Google's search results." The lawmakers claimed that 37 percent of Google Maps

results and 11 percent of Google search results for "abortion clinics near me" and "abortion pill" were for pregnancy resource centers in "trigger law" states. Signees included Sens. Amy Klobuchar (D-MN) Richard Blumenthal (D-CT), Dianne Feinstein (D-CA), Elizabeth Warren (D-MA), Chris Van Hollen (D-MD), John Hickenlooper (D-CO), Alex Padilla (D-CA), Kirsten Gillibrand (D-NY) Ed Markey (D-MA), Michael Bennet (D-CO), Tina Smith (D-MN), Bernie Sanders (I-VT), and others.

In a letter to Google's parent company Alphabet on June 28, the office of New York Attorney General Letitia James criticized the entity for allowing information about crisis pregnancy centers to appear in "abortion" search results.

"It appears that Google Maps often fails to distinguish between facilities that offer abortion services and those that do not... CPCs exist solely to intercept and dissuade pregnant people from making fully informed decisions about their healthcare such as the choice to obtain an abortion. Including these organizations in a list for an individual seeking abortion services is dangerous and misleading."

Heads of pregnancy help networks Heartbeat International, CareNet, and NIFLA responded to the misinformation propagated by lawmakers with a letter to Pichai this month, stating,

"The letter you received from several members of Congress is a blatant attempt to pull Google into an ongoing debate surrounding the abortion issue. It relies on objectively false accusations promoted by the abortion industry to shut down its competitors—namely pro-life, pro-woman pregnancy centers."

As noted by members of Congress, Google has a history of banning, throttling, and "fact-checking" pro-life advertisements. Lifenews.com reports that the members of Congress who wrote to Pichai in June attributed their information to the Center for Countering Digital Hate (CCDH), "a group that targets organizations it defines as hate groups with campaigns to de-platform and remove them from major social media outlets."

Google has bent to pressure from CCDH in the past, suppressing abortion pill reversal ads from pro-life groups Live Action and Heartbeat International at the group's behest in 2021.

Pro-Lifers Targeted

It is somewhat ironic that Joel Osteen has been targeted by pro-abortion activists. Joel Osteen is famous for avoiding controversy. Though he has said that he is pro-life, he hasn't been outspoken in his politics or in his pro-life activism.

So it is notable that three activists with a Texas pro-abortion group interrupted a service at Joel Osteen's Houston megachurch, Lakewood Church, last weekend by stripping to their underwear and shouting "my body, my choice," "Overturn Roe, Hell no," and other epithet-laced slogans.

The activists, part of the group Rise Up 4 Abortion Rights, were protesting the possibility of the Supreme Court overturning Roe v. Wade and allowing states to set their own abortion policies.

But why target Lakewood for this activism?

At least part of the answer is probably that the group knew it would generate media coverage. Lakewood, an evangelical nondenominational Christian church led by Osteen, is one of the largest congregations in the United States, with average weekly attendance in the tens of thousands.

And I should admit that this fact did cause me to think hard about this issue before we published the story. Would we not be contributing to the publicity these pro-abortion activists are seeking?

The answer I came to was: Yes, it is possible that we could be giving these activists the very publicity they are seeking, but it's also important that pro-life pastors and church leaders know that this disruption happened. This event was just one of several similar acts of disruption and vandalism by pro-abortion activists in the past week. A pregnancy resource center (PRC) in Buffalo, N.Y., was firebombed this week. Vandals in Seattle painted these words on the door and sidewalk of a PRC: "If abortion isn't safe,

you aren't either." A similar message was painted on the door of a PRC in Asheville, N.C.

In Wisconsin a group calling itself Jane's Revenge took credit for the firebombing of Wisconsin Family Action, a pro-life advocacy group.

Given these incidents, I made the decision to cover this story, even at the risk of giving the groups the publicity they seek. My bias is always that it is always better to know than not to know, to be informed rather than uninformed. The truth always sets us free. Part of the truth of this story is that the proabortion groups will get some notice that they might not otherwise have had. I can only hope that our readers will understand this story as a warning. Because if a church such as Joel Osteen's Lakewood Church can be targeted, a church that doesn't a strong stand on this issue, then no church is safe.

CHRISTIAN ORGS ARE MEETING THE NEEDS OF UKRAINIANS BY DAN HART OF THE WASHINGTON STAND

As Russia's war on Ukraine slowly fades from the headlines, the Ukrainian people continue to struggle to have their basic needs met, including critical medical care.

To help fill the void, Christian organizations like Samaritan's Purse are providing essential medical supplies to Ukraine. On Wednesday, Samaritan's Purse President and CEO Franklin Graham announced that the organization had sent its 15th cargo plane full of medical resources to Poland in order to help Ukrainian refugees in need. This latest shipment is part of a three-month relief effort that Samaritan's Purse has been undertaking in Ukraine since the beginning of Russia's invasion of the country in late February.

According to Samaritan's Purse spokesman Stephen Sneed, the organization's efforts are designed to "relieve the ongoing stress expe-

rienced by the local health system in Ukraine" after the country's Ministry of Health reached out to them for assistance. He went on to state that a total of 17 airlifts have been deployed, which have totaled "over 140,000 metric tons of medical relief supplies [including] pharmaceuticals and medical consumables such as bandages, IV supplies, antiseptics, surgical supplies, casting, and splinting material."

CHINA CONTINUES CAMPAIGN TO SHUT DOWN ONLINE WORSHIP GATHERINGS

It's been more than two months since China's online religious restrictions went into effect, and many Christians in China agree the harsh changes are forcing them to get creative to continue meeting virtually.

Believers are finding new ways to communicate on WeChat, a widely used smartphone messenger app within the country. An Open Doors partner explains: "[Christians] play on words in coded language, as a way to encode sensitive keywords to lay low from being banned or deleted for posting 'illegal content."

If certain phrases or banned words appear in a post, a reminder to remove any sensitive keywords flashes on the content creator's screen. Our Open Doors partner continued: "So far, we are still able to meet virtually on a regular basis by using various communication tools and platforms interchangeably. Coping with censorship, we are trying to stay more vigilant with word choices over texts."



MIDDLE EAST COUNCIL OF CHURCHES MEETS IN EGYPT BY KAREN FAULKNER, WORTHY NEWS CORRESPONDENT

The General Assembly of the Middle East Council of Churches (MECC) has been able to hold a meeting in Egypt for the first time, International Christian Concern (ICC) reports. That this Christian organization was allowed to meet in Egypt is notable, given that the country ranks 20 on the US Open Doors World Watch List of top 50 countries where Christians are persecuted.

Over the course of the meeting, MECC church leaders discussed how to help the needy among their congregations and expressed their "sadness at the massive emigration of

young people which is weakening Middle Eastern societies and drastically reducing the number of many local Christian communities," ICC said. In the face of turmoil around the world, leaders encouraged congregants to heed to the words of Jesus: "Take courage, it is I; do not be afraid" (Matthew 14:27).

PLANE SERVING MISSIONARIES ATTACKED AND BURNED IN

Missionaries throughout Haiti, the Dominican Republic, and the Bahamas look forward to the weekly arrivals of planes flown by Agape Flights, a Florida ministry founded in 1980 that shuttles mail, medicines, cargo, relief supplies, and other resources.

But one of its planes won't be flying any more. It was burned in Haiti by demonstrators protesting the country's increasing violence and kidnappings, which increased 180% in 2021, according to a report from Florida TV station WWSB.

The Piper Chieftain was moving at the Antoine Simon Des Cayes airport in Les Cayes on Haiti's southern coast when demonstrators attacked. Seven Agape Flights employees are safe and staying with missionaries until they can safely leave the country.




