From the Heart: My Uncle and Me

I would say that my Uncle Jack (John Duckhorn) was a part of my story from the beginning. He and I were born on the same date, so I was his 14th birthday present.

One of my earliest memories of him was this guy who showed up at our house at the Wilson Park Housing Project. He would ride up on a threewheel ice cream motor bike and my mom would yell, "Danny, Uncle Jack's here!" He would go up and down the street and sell ice cream bars to the kids and I'd be standing between his legs and the handlebars. I knew he was a special person.

I remember my dad dramatically tell-

ing people how, "Jack fell on his knees and gave his life to Jesus." I wish my dad had done that. It's wild to think I was young and re-

My Uncle started taking me to church at Ebeneezer on 42nd and Oklahoma. The first day he walked me into a back hallway somewhere by the alley and then down a flight of steps to a Sunday school room. A bunch of kids were sitting on the floor, and a lady, Jewel Paradise, was playing the piano. I think I was about four. She stopped the class as they were singing and said, "Danny, what's your favorite song?" I didn't know any church songs, so I said, "Popeye the sailor man." She didn't know that one. That began my time at Ebeneezer, going through the ranks of Sunday school and sitting with my uncle in the services, counting the ceiling tiles and drawing pictures on the bulletins with his New Tribes buddies.

Bob and Jewel sponsored me so that I could go to Camp Willow Bay at Lake Geneva when I was eight. My uncle was the primary mover and shaker in terms of getting me to camp and church. I'm sure he had talks with me, none of which I can remember, but I knew I really loved him.

It was one of those years, when I was 10, that I gave my life to Christ. It was a long and faraway memory that came back to mind when I was 20. The Lord made it memorable by what happened. I remember walking with my counselor up to our cabin Navajo one or two, and then up in the window I saw this kid Dale Deeds peeking out. Of course, I didn't want to talk to my counselor with Dale in the room. We went in and there was no Dale, so I crawled under a bunkbed and pulled back the suitcases and there he was. And out he went.

When my Uncle went to South America as a missionary, my attendance at church stopped but my parents still made sure that I got to camp. I know my uncle was praying for me, but those were wild years.

I got out of the Air Force in 1974. Vietnam was winding down and they needed people to step out to make room for the guys who were coming back from Thailand. I was willing to do that, so they gave me an honorable discharge, and I went back to Milwaukee.

In Milwaukee, I got back with my lost friends and realized that I was lost.

It just so happened that my uncle was on furlough that year, and I remember one time we were up at Lake Emily, walking along the road. He was having a heart-to-heart with me and I was frustrating him by telling him all the things I had "learned" using drugs. Yet, as I was saying things, everything coming out of my mouth sounded so stupid. Finally, my Uncle said, "Danny, a person will try anything before they try Jesus." When he said that, I said, "You're right, a person will try anything before they try Jesus."

As we were walking, I asked, "Why in the world did God make life. It's terrible?" Just as I said that a car went by and I realized he didn't hear me. It was okay. I vocalized something that was really bothering me. As I left to go back to Milwaukee he said, "You know, maybe you should try to read the Bible." I answered that I tried, and I died in the third book. He told me to start with Matthew. I thought that was a good idea. As I was driving back that night, I pulled onto a side road, got on the hood of my Gremlin, leaned back against the windshield and prayed again, "God if you're there, I really want to know."

The first thing I had to do when I got back to Milwaukee was to find a Bible. My mom kicked me out of the house, but growing up in Milwaukee, I had advanced breaking and entering skills. I took the old family Bible I used to take to Ebeneezer. I would take my dog out to the Root River Parkway, sit on a hill, and read Matthew. It was like it was on fire. What really got me was Jesus on the cross saying, "Father, forgive them for they know not what they do." That was me and it hit me hard.

I can't exactly tell you how things changed, but there came another meeting with my uncle. I had moved back home and after a while my mom called my Uncle and told him there was something wrong with me. I was being polite and helping with the rent, etc...probably a major brain injury!

I remember sitting with him and he would ask me questions I couldn't answer. Finally, he asked what I thought about Jesus. That was easy. I believed He died for me and I wanted to follow Him.

That launched us into discipleship. He was living in Waukesha and I went out there many evenings. He would feed me Coke and chips and take his little notepad out and draw me all sorts of pictures and show me all sorts of stuff in the Bible. It was an important time.

I never thought I'd be in full-time work, but what a joy it's been to have him always 14 years ahead of me to give me good advice when I've needed it. The Lord has done amazing things in my Uncle's life, and he's definitely been the greatest "birthday" gift that the Lord has given to me.

Appeal to Heaven: Members of Congress Join to Pray for Nation

Thirty days into an increasingly painful government shutdown - and political divides as deep as they've ever been - a group of House conservatives is making it clear that while Washington may not have the solution to America's problems. God does. As frustrations boil over in Congress and the country struggles to cope with the fallout, the House Freedom Caucus - together with Family Research Council — decided to host a special "Congress Prays for America" call Thursday evening to ask, not just for an end to the leaders' impasse, but also for spiritual healing in our broken land.



"When Members of Congress bow their heads together," Dr. Andy Harris (R-Md.) and FRC President Tony Perkins insisted in a joint column announcing the event, "they acknowledge that the power to restore this nation doesn't lie in the levers of politics, but in the hands of Providence. God can bring revival to the very place where division has taken root: the United States Capitol."

Pausing to recognize the significance of the moment, Harris told people at the beginning of the call, "It's not often in Washington that we pause long to admit that no matter how strong our convictions or how fierce the debates around us, we are ultimately dependent on someone far greater than ourselves. Prayer isn't a sign of weakness," he wanted those assembled to know. "It's a declaration of humility that our wisdom is limited, our strength is finite, and our hope rests in the hands of a faithful God. In times like these," he insisted, "when our nation feels divided, when political violence and fear threaten to harden our hearts, prayer is exactly what we need."

At the end of the day, Harris emphasized, "We can draft laws and cast votes, but only God can change hearts. Scripture reminds us, if my people who are called by my name will humble themselves and pray. And that's what we're doing tonight. So as we begin this call, I ask each of you to open your hearts. May He hear us tonight."

For close to an hour, congressmen from Pennsylvania to Arizona asked God's mercy, wisdom, and guidance on the nation and its leaders. They prayed specifically for President Donald Trump, for peace in Israel, for an end to the violent rhetoric, for protection from our enemies, and provision in times of lack. As Perkins underscored from the outset, "We gather with the recognition that we need God's help."

Rep. Mark Harris (R-N.C.), like so many, expressed his gratitude for the rare opportunity to humbly link arms with other elected officials "at this very hour to seek your face, to call out your name, to know that our dependence is ultimately upon you. [We are here] seeking your grace and your mercy as you move mightily across this nation." His colleague, Illinois Congresswoman Mary Miller (R), expressed her dismay at the confusion gripping our nation. "I just pray for wisdom," she declared. "Lord, you said that death and life are in the power of the tongue. I pray you'd help us speak words that restore and words that can reconcile people back to Yourself and Your word and exalt You. And Lord, we are reminded that [Your] ways are perfect and every word of God is true."

Dr. Frank Turek, who was at Charlie Kirk's side when he drew his last breath, specifically prayed for civility to return to our nation. "Help us

to be peacemakers," he implored. "Help us to stand on the truth without being caustic, without being unkind. But help us to stand and reach out to those [who] oppose us. We're to pray for our enemies," he said, "so that's what we're doing here today. We have seen so much violence. There's an aura of rage about the country. Much of it makes absolutely no sense. It can only be demonic in nature. So we pray it away."

"Hear, Lord, hear our cry for mercy," Turek continued. "Sovereign Lord, my strong deliverer, You shield us in the day of battle. Do not grant the wicked their desires. Lord, do not let their plans succeed. May Your plan succeed that they become Christians. [Help] the Christians become more like You. We're here to know You and to make you known. Help us to do that better."

Closing the time of prayer was former Trump official, Dr. Ben Carson, who insisted that the need to unite in prayer was never more timely. "Lord, we come before you today to pray for our nation," he began. "You have blessed the United States with freedom and opportunity and a rich legacy of faith. You've taken us from a ragtag bunch of militiamen to the pinnacle of the world in record time. But we know that all goodness comes from you, Lord, and without You, we can do nothing. We ask for your healing upon the divisions in our nation," he reiterated. "Our nation is so strong that it can't be taken down militarily, but it can be taken down from inside — and there are many agents trying to facilitate that."

"We need you," Carson insisted, "Your wisdom and Your guidance for our leaders. Please restore the righteousness in our homes, integrity in our institutions, unity among our people."

Reflecting on the seriousness of the hour, Harris and Perkins agreed: "This isn't just a national prayer call from Congress. It's a step toward something our country desperately needs — a spiritual revival and awakening." In these challenges, they wanted people to know, "America's hope doesn't rest in Washington, but it can start there."

BIBLE SALES SURGE 36% AFTER ASSASSINATION OF CHRISTIAN ACTIVIST CHARLIE KIRK - WORTHY CHRISTIAN NEWS

In the weeks following the assassination of Christian political activist Charlie Kirk, Americans have turned to Scripture in record numbers — a striking indicator of renewed spiritual hunger across the nation.

According to newly released data from Circana BookScan, Bible sales surged 36% in September compared to the same month last year, reaching 2.4 million copies sold — up from 1.5 million in August. Until that point, monthly sales in 2025 had remained

relatively stable between 1.2 million and 1.6 million copies.

"People started to think about what they believe and why," said Mark Schoenwald, president and CEO of HarperCollins Christian Publishing, the country's largest publisher of Bibles and Christian literature. "It awakened a lot of them."

HarperCollins reported that young adults aged 18 to 34 accounted for a significant portion of the spike, suggesting a generational shift toward renewed interest in Scripture and faith-based resources.

Analysts note that this surge reflects a recurring national pattern: in moments of grief,

uncertainty, or moral upheaval, Americans often rediscover faith.

Bible sales have been trending upward for the past two years. Between January and September 2025, sales rose 11% over the same period last year. In 2024, sales



were up 22% compared to 2023 — signaling a steady, multi-year revival of interest in the Word of God that appears to have now reached new heights in the wake of Kirk's death

SOLID FOOD FOR A STARVING CHURCH BY ALEX MCFARLAND

"For though by this time you ought to be teachers, you need someone to teach you again the first principles of the oracles of God; and you have come to need milk and not solid food." — Hebrews 5:12 (NKJV)

There's a hunger in the church today—a deep, aching hunger. But it's not for entertainment, programs, or even community. It's for truth. For depth. For solid spiritual food.

Hebrews 5 reminds us that spiritual maturity isn't optional—it's expected. Yet many churches are still serving milk when the body of Christ is crying out for meat. God wants to do so much more through His church. Let's rise together to the task of creating mature disciples of Christ.

In times past, the church was the intellectual center of the community. Consider John Wesley, who believed the local congregation



deserved the highest scholarship the church could offer. Or Thomas Aquinas, who taught farmers before dawn in Italy, preaching through the Apostles' Creed in preparation for Easter. These weren't ivory tower lectures—they were accessible, but rich. Scholarly, but pastoral.

We need that again.

I believe the church must lead by example and by challenge, spurring believers on to great learning. Christianity is a uniquely cerebral faith. Romans 12:2 calls us to the renewing of our minds—not just our emotions or habits. The renewed mind is one that reflects the mind of God.

But Romans 1:28 warns us of the opposite: the reprobate mind. That word means "inconvenient"—a mind that no longer functions as it was designed to. A mind that can no longer apprehend truth or experience the Lord. That's not just tragic—it's terrifying.

We must be stewards of our minds. The church must teach believers to think biblically, reason theologically, and live wisely. This isn't elitism—it's discipleship.

So pastors, teachers, leaders: preach the Word. Teach doctrine. Challenge your people to grow. Let's raise up a generation that doesn't just feel their faith—but understands it, defends it, and lives it out with conviction.

Because the world is starving. And the church must serve solid food.

NRB PRESIDENT & CEO TROY A. MILLER HEADS TO ISRAEL AMID KEY MOMENT IN U.S.-ISRAEL RELATIONS

"Visiting Israel in this moment brings clarity you can't get from a distance," said Miller. We stand shoulder to shoulder with our Jewish brothers and sisters, praying for peace and bearing wit-

ness to hope amid hardship."

Miller's trip comes during a defining moment in U.S.-Israel relations, following recent high-level visits from Vice President J.D. Vance and Secretary of State Antony Blinken. Vice President Vance's meetings in Jerusa-

lem reaffirmed that the United States stands beside Israel as an equal ally, emphasizing continued coordination and support for Israel's security and regional peace.

While in Israel, Miller will visit key regions including Samaria, northern border communities, and towns near the Gaza Strip. He will also participate in a featured panel titled "The Importance of the Christian World's Support of Israel," alongside Rabbi Israel Meir Lau, former Chief Rabbi of Israel.

Miller has led multiple solidarity trips to Israel for Christian leaders, equipping communicators to speak with biblical and historical clarity about the land and its people. Under his leadership, NRB has deepened partnerships with faith organizations and reaffirmed its support for Israel's sovereignty and right to its ancestral homeland.

PUMPKIN BREAD

3 1/2 c. flour

2 tsp. baking soda

1 1/2 tsp. salt

1 tsp. Chinese Five spices (Chinese Five spices can be found in the oriental section of your grocery store.)

1 tsp. nutmeg

3 c. sugar

4 eggs

1 can (15 oz.) pumpkin

1 c. oil

2/3 c. water

1 c. chopped walnuts

Topping:

1/4 c. melted butter

1/4 c. sugar

1 tsp. Chinese Five spices

Preheat oven to 350°. Combine dry ingredients together; mix well; set aside. Combine sugar, eggs, pumpkin, oil and water; mix well. Add walnuts. Add to dry ingredients and stir only until incorporated. Bake in 2 greased bread pans (9x5) or 4 (8x4) pans for 45-60 minutes, or until tests done with toothpick. Leave in pan 10 minutes; remove. For topping, brush tops of bread with butter. Combine sugar and Chinese Five and sprinkle over butter. Continue cooling on wire racks. Can be wrapped well and frozen. Great for Christmas gifts!

Navigating a Hostile World: 5 Ways Christians Can Stand Firm with Grace and Truth

How should Christians respond to a world increasingly hostile toward Christians and the values they proclaim?

This pressing question was explored during a panel discussion at Family Research Council's 2025 Pray Vote Stand Summit over the weekend, where thousands of believers gathered for two days of worship, learning, and equipping to stand resolute in their faith. The panelists offered a multifaceted approach to engaging a hostile culture with compassion, conviction, and biblical grounding. Here are five key insights from their discussion.

1. Winning Hearts or Winning Debates?

Engaging a hostile world begins with rejecting its combative tone. "[W]e're to speak the truth in love," said FRC President Tony Perkins. And yet, "oftentimes when we get into these discussions, we want to win a debate as opposed to winning a heart" — a perspective that usually only deepens the divide. That's when Mike Winger, founder of BibleThinker, chimed in, stating that "biblically speaking, you actually care about the other person."

Speaking with someone we're at odds with can be challenging, but as Winger further explained, "[W]e can be passionate ... about where the country is or where our churches are at. But am I passionate about that individual and them changing their mind or getting at least a seed planted?" Anyone can change their mind later "down the road," but "the agenda is transformation on the other side, not just a victory."

How do you view the person you're talking to? This, as Perkins noted, is a fundamental question to ask yourself when navigating these kinds of conversations. If you see them as a sinner in need of saving and blinded by darkness, chances are, you may find yourself far more compassionate and loving toward them than you thought possible.

2. The "Theology of Losing Friends"

Founder and President of Them Before Us Katy Faust put it bluntly. If Christians are to share truth in an age that cancels truth tellers, then we must "develop a theology of losing friends." She encouraged believers to prioritize relationships and initiate connections with those who disagree, but to set biblical boundaries. "[Y]ou need to think ahead of time," she said, "and you need to think biblically." What are you not willing to do simply to keep the relationship? Are you willing to lose a friend if it means not compromising?

Scripture is clear that the world will hate Christians because it first hates and rejects Christ (John 15:18). As such, for believers willing to stand firm, losing friendships is an inevitable reality. But as Faust emphasized, when you lose that friendship, you should be able to say, "[I've] lost the relationship. Not because I was a jerk ... unprepared ... uninformed, or I was doing too much truth telling and not enough grace giving. [I] lost the relationship because the only way for me to keep it was to compromise on what I believe." This, Faust urged, is not only "an acceptable reason to lose a friend," but it's also "what honoring your Lord looks like in ... a hostile culture."

3. Care about What the Bible Cares about

Christians must engage with all issues the Bible addresses, even those deemed "secondary." Winger explained how Jesus Himself spoke on taxes and divorce, even if what He said was not accepted. Of course, sharing the gospel is crucial for Christians, but it's a "narrow view of the gospel" to think that Christians can not or should not address other conversations within culture.

Winger went further: "[W]e've underestimated how much these secondary issues are actually our neighbor's primary issues." For many, issues concerning life, gender, identity, and more sit at the "center of their worldview. ... And when you leave that alone, you're leav-



ing the stronghold center of their worldview alone" — the very aspect "that's making them resistant to the gospel of Christ." There are plenty of people who struggle with homosexuality, unchallenged by the truth of Scripture, who may agree to go to church. Yet, Winger noted, "when [their sin] finally gets confronted, they just bail."

Christians can't "abandon central issues our people are dealing with," Winger stressed, because then "we leave them alone without any guidance from the light of the world on these issues that are destroying their souls."

4. Be Engaged by Finding Your Identity in Christ, Not in Politics

Political engagement can spark spiritual revival, as Faust observed: "[P]olitical conservatism has led to a spiritual revival" when Christians speak with "sanity and evidence." Natasha Crain, author of "When Culture Hates You," chimed in, remarking, "There's always the risk that we can conflate our identity. ... We need to identify the risks" to avoid "conflating our Christian identity with any kind of political identity."

However, Crain argued, "My concern is sometimes, when we're talking about those risks, we never get past the risk." Christians often spend a lot of time warning other Christians of the negative consequences of getting wrapped up in politics that they forget to address what it should look like — how Christians can faithfully engage in a way that sparks positive change. From Crain's observation, "A lot of that pressure [Christian's face] to hide because of ... hostility comes from within the church."

There are many "leaders within the church," she emphasized, "a lot of pastors who are doing so much of the warning ... that it makes us shrink back and go, 'Oh, I guess I shouldn't want to impose my values on others,' or, 'I guess I shouldn't be seeking the power to do things right.' We hear all of these kind of mantras in the church." Yet, "When you pull them back, you realize that they're really not logically consistent. They're not biblically consistent. We are called to be salt and light" and "follow Jesus's commands ... to love God [and] others. ... [P]art of loving others ... is caring about their lives in the context of the societies in which they live."

Ultimately, it's an identity found in Christ alone that allows Christians to engage in politics without making an identity out of it. And when you are criticized for voicing God's truth, Winger encouraged believers to "ignore them and keep moving forward." And if you're scared to speak up at all and are concerned you aren't equipped, Winger added, "I would rather stumble forward and kind of mess up a little along the way and try to change the world than to just sit back. ... I'm not worried about my identity. My identity is in Christ." But "do I have the guts and the courage and the fortitude to stand

up and continue to defend the truth against even this in-crowd that we're talking about? That's the test."

5. God's Word: The Anchor in the Cultural Storm

Above all, Perkins asserted, "We've got to be in the word of God, and we need to be in churches that are preaching the word of God" — especially "if we're going to have the confidence to stand in this increasingly hostile culture."

Furthermore, by being grounded in the word, Christians can better understand how the biblical worldview is not invalid. As Winger put it, "[W]e need to relearn how to be utterly unashamed of our Christian grounding ... worldview ... purposes, and reasons, and then explore the borders." And if you're accused of "trying to force your values on people," he added, you can say, "Yes, I am. ... Every-

one's trying to force values. I'm trying to force good values that are grounded in truth and God. ... [Y]ou're trying to force values that you see as valuable, you see as good, but they're not grounded in truth, in God."

"We're in a moment," Perkins observed. "How do we make the most of this?"

The panelists called Christians to action: mobilize, as Winger urged, by actively engaging culture; immerse yourself in Scripture, as Crain advocated, to ground your worldview; and embrace justice, as Faust emphasized, to protect the vulnerable. In a constitutional republic, Christians have the freedom to share their values boldly, and by anchoring themselves in God's word, speaking truth with love, and standing firm without compromising, Christians can navigate a hostile world with grace, courage, and transformative impact.





Evangelicals in Office? 'We're Asking the Living God to Move into the Public Square of America'

When President Trump returned to the White House, his message resonated with many Americans when he talked about a "revolution of common sense." Now, some conservatives want another revolution: a movement of pastors and parishioners running for political office

"What we're doing is spiritual, the byproduct is political," says David Lane, the head of the American Renewal Project. His organization has been focusing specifically on the swing state of North Carolina with the goal of convincing 500 North Carolina pastors, spiritual leaders or churchgoers to run for various positions from school board to city council to even Congress.

At a recent event in Raleigh, North Carolina, President Trump videotaped a message to pastors and their wives who assembled at the gathering. "Across the state you have inspired dozens of faith leaders to run for office and win elections and they've been winning them in droves," President Trump told the group. "I will be cheering you on as you recruit 500 church members to run for office in 2026 and 2028."

Four years ago, the American Renewal Project successfully recruited 50 pastors and spiritual leaders for statewide offices – 25 won their primaries and 10 won the general election. "If we stay home, the other side's put their candidates in, who then draft and pass legislation and codify into law their values," David Lane told the gathering

in Raleigh. "We're asking the living God to move into the public square of America."



Overall, the 2026 Mid-

terms are already looking to be a dogfight as a handful of states across the country are changing their redistricting rules. Just this week, Missouri's Republican governor signed into law a new map that could net the GOP an additional congressional seat. Texas drew first with a map to benefit the GOP in the midterms. Red states like Indiana and Florida are also planning to do the same. Meanwhile, Democrats are trying to redistrict in the blue states of California, Maryland, and New York.

As these political maneuvers play out, North Carolina Congressman Pat Harrigan says the battle ahead is focused on something much bigger. "I've always spoken the truth, and I will always continue to speak the truth," Harrigan explained to pastors in Raleigh. "We are not winning. We are making progress, but we are not winning. There is still a mountain of work to do, and it will take all of our lifetimes to undo what has been done in this country to sow sin instead of righteousness."

While it might take a lifetime, members of this movement believe the result will be worth the work and that now is the time to start.

Words Matter

Today I want to talk about how words matter. Words can be powerful. They can lift you up and encourage you. They can convey love and they can also communicate hate. The words you say to your spouse; to your kids; to your neighbors; to your coworkers - they all matter. The words you choose to listen to matter. They will affect you, whether you realize it or not. Jesus understood that words matter. During his time on earth he spoke many comforting words. In John 14:27 he said [Jhn 14:27 KJV] 27 Peace I leave with you, my peace I give unto you: not as the world giveth, give I unto you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid.

A well written speech by a great orator can inspire and unify people. Abraham Lincoln's Gettysburg Address emphasized the ideal of a nation "conceived in Liberty, and dedicated to the proposition that all men are created equal," and the enduring principle of "government of the people, by the people, for the people".

John F Kennedy's inaugural speech encouraged a generation to public service when he stated ""Ask not what your country can do for you—ask what you can do for your country,"

Martin Luther King's "I have a dream" speech galvanized the nation to finally address racial inequity in a land where "all men are created equal".

These were inspiring, Biblically-based words. Calls to action to affect positive outcomes.

But you know, the same can be done with evil words. A dictator, through the use of words, can brainwash a nation to propagate war and genocide. As morbid as it may seem, the study of Nazi propaganda in the 1930's has always fascinated me. How could an entire nation turn on the Jewish living amongst them? How could an entire nation fall under the hypnotizing control of a murderous thug like Adolph Hitler? Propaganda was the key - the insidious drip of strategic words, using all forms of media, declaring one group of people was to blame for everything; that they were sub-human and should be eliminated from society. Looking at today's news outlets and the words they use, it seems nothing has changed.

When it comes to propaganda, words are carefully chosen for the desired effect on the audience. We live in a world where words are intentionally twisted, to soften the blow of sin, or coerce someone into a false sense of self-righteousness. We routinely hear that

- It's "reproductive health care", instead of abortion, the definition of which is the murder of an unborn child.
- It's "gender affirming care", instead of the deliberate lying to a young person as you pump them with life-altering drugs; committing atrocious, irreversible surgery
- It's a lifestyle choice, claiming "love is love", when we know it to be sinful behavior, condemned by God

Over the past 10 years, words in the main stream media have been carefully chosen. People like us in this room have been labelled as "Christian nationalists", Christian extremists; racists; fascists; even Nazis. They tell their audience over and over again that WE are the existential threat to American society; we should be shamed and removed from society. What's behind this? Who do we know that is a master of lies; who twists truth and pollutes righteousness?

I mention all of this because it's been a really tough week. The horrific assassination of Charlie Kirk has changed me in ways I can't yet articulate. Something has shifted within me, and from what I'm seeing on the internet, it has also affected millions across this country. This was a turning point. A line has been crossed and people, not just Christians, are waking up to the reality of the wickedness in our world.

I was a big fan and follower of Charlie Kirk. I watched him every day. Within minutes of hearing that Charlie had been shot, I was on social media looking to see if it was true. I desperately wanted it NOT to be true. All too quickly I found numerous posts of the shooting - one second he was speaking, the next his neck exploded and a shocking amount of blood was pouring out of him as he slumped to the ground. People screamed and ran in all directions to escape. At first I thought it was AI generated - something fake that some twisted, evil ghoul created to fool all of us. There was so much blood it looked like something out of a movie, not real life. But then I saw the same footage, except from different angles, from people near him in the audience. To say I was stunned would be a gross understatement. I ran to my wife and showed her. She was horrified. We burst into tears, unable to process brutality and violence of what we were seeing. His 3 year old daughter tried to run to him, scared by the sound of the gunshot and the screaming of the crowd. She wanted to find safety in her Daddy's arms.

Later that day, before we learned he was officially dead, there were some on social media asking for these videos to be taken down, stating it was cruel to keep them up in case Charlie's wife or children were to see them. I disagreed – I was now angry enough at what had happened that I wanted everyone to see the horrific reality. If you haven't seen it, I respectfully encourage you to find it and watch it once. If your kids are age appropriate show it to them. You may disagree with me but we can't avert our eyes anymore from the wicked evil that roams this earth.

I miss the America I grew up in. We were never this divided. Evil was not this out in the open. This week people were celebrating his assassination and posting their celebration on social media for all to see. There is no shame anymore, no remorse. No civil discourse. No respect of life, of innocence. No sympathy for a widow and her two young children. As I read these awful posts, the words of Ephesians 6:12 came crashing in as a stark reminder - [Eph 6:12 KJV] 12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high [places].

Growing up, I would read the stories in the New Testament of demon possessed people, thinking to myself "I'm glad we don't have that these days". I was so naïve. I believe now we have more demon possessed people walking amongst us than ever before. Satan has grown more bold, and has better tools and resources to reach people on a global scale. His goal has never changed – to twist the truth of God's words into lies; to blind the eyes of people; to convince them that happiness and contentment can be found elsewhere other than in God. I hate what he's doing to our world; to our country; to our children.

Friday night Darla and I watched Erika Kirk's speech and were brought to tears again. Her strength; her broken heart; her resolution to carry on the work Charlie had started – it was so incredibly inspiring. Only someone with Christ as their rock, anchor, and strong tower could have had the courage to do that. Pray for her. Pray for her children. Pray for the Turning Point movement that must not be silenced.

I mentioned earlier something inside of me has changed. I can no longer see the world

through a political lens. Politics are just a vehicle to accomplish an ultimate goal. No, my lens is now 100% spiritual. You see, just like the book Done describes two world religions - one focused on the false hope of DOING enough to warrant a place in heaven, and the other accepting what has already been DONE for you to be with your Savior for eternity - there are only two groups of people in this world - those who have Christ, and those who don't. Other labels placed on groups of people based on race, gender, political affiliation, denomination are absolutely meaningless if you hold to a spiritual lens. For those who have Christ, we lost a global ambassador for Christ in Charlie Kirk.

Charlie Kirk is a modern-day Christian martyr. I knew Christians were being martyred across the world, but you rarely if ever see it and so you become desensitized to what's happening. Witnessing Charlie's assassination almost in real time woke me from my apathetic slumber. He was an unashamed Christian who shared the gospel every chance he had. He used words to try to open the eyes of those who had been lied to for so long through evil propaganda in the news media; on social media; and in our public schools and universities. I never met this man, yet why does his death hurt so much? Someone pointed out because the body of Christ is mourning his loss. Paul wrote in I Corinthians [1Co 12:26 KJV] 26 And whether one member suffer, all the members suffer with it; or one member be honored, all the members rejoice with it.

Those without Christ painted him as a racist, Nazi, homophobe, fascist; they said he was the great divider and his so-called "hate speech" had to be stopped. If you've ever seen his videos on campuses across the country, debating anyone with the courage

to step up to the mic, you would see the exact opposite. He was polite; he was thoughtful; he was welcoming; and he was compassionate. Within hours of the confirmation of his assassination, those without Christ were back on the air lying about him; blaming HIM and his words for being murdered. I want to hate these people but I know that's not what Jesus wants.

In spite of this terrible week I have good news. Those without Christ think he's been silenced, but the exact opposite has happened. His martyrdom has ignited people like never before. I watched on social media as numerous people declared their love for Christ; I watched as people woke up to the reality that they need Christ; many rededicated themselves to Christ; to going to church again; to opening their Bible. I saw people who didn't know Christ show interest in reading the Bible, to find out why Charlie was always talking about his Savior. I saw a post that said "You can't kill a Christian, you can only change his address."

Charlie's death will not be in vain. Millions of us, shaken to a heightened awareness by this loss, will see to that. His message, and his mission, will carry on. I want to be a part of that. He only spoke the truth, and people wanted him dead because of it.

Therefore, I will no longer allow people to blaspheme my God. I will no longer allow them to mock and ridicule my Savior. I will stand up and speak out [Rom 1:16 KJV] 16 For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God unto salvation to every one that believeth.

You can call me a racist, a fascist, a Nazi, a Christian nationalist – those words have no power over me. Christ will be my example. They killed him for his words. Even

on the cross he begged the Father to forgive his murderers, for they knew not what they were doing. He was never hateful. He never wanted violence. Yet that's all I ever see from those without Christ.

I will speak the truth in love to those who hurl those words at me. You need Jesus my friend. He will open your eyes. He will change your heart. He is light, and truth, and our loving Shepherd. He died in your place, so you won't have to pay your sin debt. He rose from the grave and promises to return for his people. Who wouldn't want that?

I will pray for the lost. I will pray for our country. I will pray that a revival of global proportions will sweep across our world in the coming months. Because this assassination is in the news and on everyone's minds, we must use this opportunity to share the gospel with all we encounter.

In the name of Jesus Christ I rebuke you Satan. Get thee behind me. For too long we've been complacent. For too long we've let you take over our country, poisoning our youth, destroying our homes, destroying our country from within. I'm on the winning side. You may have won this week's battle by taking out a threat to your kingdom, but the WAR is already won. You've lost.

Christians, daily we must put on the armor of God; arm yourself with the sword of the Lord because HIS words definitely matter. Face the evil darkness and extinguish it with the light of His word. Teach your kids His truth, His words. Don't let the words of others influence them. Strengthen your marriage in Christ. Be ambassadors for Christ wherever you go. Show and tell the world the difference Jesus can make in your life. Our complacency has to end.


A Glimpse of Eternity


